Main Topic: It will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be as sweet as honey

The world is meaningless. The effort one put toward the world will be meaningless. Only the gospel is power. The more you share the gospel; the more power will be with you and you will be remembered in the Kingdom of heaven.

Main Bible Verse:

(Revelation 10:9-11) So I went to the angel and told him to give me the little scroll. And he said to me, "Take and eat it; it will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be sweet as honey." And I took the little scroll from the hand of the angel and ate it. It was sweet as honey in my mouth, but when I had eaten it my stomach was made bitter. And I was told, "You must again prophesy about many peoples and nations and languages and kings."

Summary:

- 1. (John 1:1-3) Jesus is truth. In the beginning there was Word and the Word was Him. God created heaven and earth. All things are created by Him and only Him. Therefore, we must give the glory to God and we must pray that God's creation to be in our lives.
- 2. (Matthew 5:3, 10) Jesus taught us, two of the Beatitude mentioned the kingdom of heaven are theirs.
- a. Blessed are the poor in spirit
 - Poor in spirit means not to have a different heart. It means our heart and our lips should not give glory man or thing. When we understand that glory belongs to God, the kingdom of heaven will enter our heart.
 - (Romans 10:14) When we come to church meetings, if we do not worship God wholeheartedly, we will not be able to hear or to see Him. But God wants to let us hear and to let us see. When we come to church, we must come for only the Lord and with a humble attitude. Then God will let us see and let us hear, for He wants us to see His power and glory.
 - When we understand the importance of offering, our life, our time, and our tithe, we will see God's creation in the work of our hands. When we give glory to God and truly knowing that all our blessings are from God, the kingdom of heaven will enter into our heart. The more we give glory to God, the more the creation of God will be in our lives.
- b. Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness
 - (Matthew 5:11-12) When you share the gospel, some will praise you, but others will insult you or dislike you. But no matter how they treat you, you must bless them and thank them, for God taught us, the kingdom of heaven are for those who are persecuted because of righteousness.
- 3. (Revelation 10:9-11) Make your stomach bitter: God look at your heart. Did you really take in God's word? When God taught us that love is patient (1 Corinthians 13:4), did you act upon it. When others persecute you, you must pray for them with this verse. When you do so, you will realize that the kindness that comes after patience will be upon you. This is when the word truly become part of your life. Though you might feel the bitterness while doing so, it will be sweet in your life, for your lips will be able to speak of prophecy and your voice will have power.
- 4. (1 Corinthians 13:4) Love is patient, love is kind. Love is the way to your success and patience is your method. Afterwards, you will receive the life of kindness (fruit of kindness). The quality of our life does not rely on the duration of us being at church, but the love and patience in our lives.
- 5. How to receive God's blessing? We must take the little scroll and eat it. Eat it daily and change our life daily, then we will see the work of God in our lives. However, before we receive our blessings, he thief (satin) will attempt to come

and steal (steal your faith), kill (kill your relationships with others), and to destroy (destroy the prophecy God gave you). We must be alert.

- 6. (1 Corinthians 9:26-27/Romans 10:14) Our enemy is not others, but the corruption of our faith. Therefore, our prayers and our run must have direction. Which means, when you receive the word of God, you must keep it. Continue to attend church meetings and the promise of God will come to pass.
- 7. (Romans 10:13/Revelation 21:2) When we call on to the name of the Lord, we will be saved. But God taught us this is only the beginning. We must continue to effort in the life of rapture. For the new Jerusalem will come down out of heaven from God. God has taught us that those who overcame and be raptured will reign with Jesus for one thousand years.
 - v(Revelation 20:6) Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years.
- 8. How do we have a life of rapture? The answer is to eat the little scroll, which means to meditate God's word and to act upon it in our lives. If one could worship and speak of God's word, but could not act upon it, it is not eating the little scroll.
- 9. How do we eat the little scroll? Memorize the scriptures and pray until God speaks to you. God will send angels to help you understand the scriptures and show you directions. When you follow this direction, you will see God's creation, then all you do will be successful.
- 10. (Revelation 10:11/Psalms 103:19-20) We must read the scriptures until we are enlightened and empowered. Our success is in the prayer. But we must act upon God's word after we pray, then Jesus will become our way, our truth, and our life.

Conclusion:

We must memorize the scriptures daily. Memorize until it makes our stomach bitter, memorize until the word of God be activated in your life, then you will receive power in your lips. You will realize that your lips are sweet and full of anointing. This is the mystery of eating the little scroll. It will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be as sweet as honey.
