- 6. (Matthew 12:33-34/Proverbs 4:23) Paul taught us, we must listen to God's word and to act upon it, for Jesus looks at our hearts.
- 7. We must pay attention to God's word and to the commission that God has bestowed upon us. Therefore, we must pray and ask for the strength and wisdom to become a faithful, wise, and alert Christian.
- 8. First stay faithful in the commission God has bestowed upon you. We must be willing to become a vessel of God and practice to share the gospel. We must follow God's word carefully and to make it part of our lives. When we are able to live God's word out, our live will become a wonderful testimony of God.
- 9. - 10. Change the way we eat: (Acts 15:29) You are to abstain from food sacrificed to idols, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals and from sexual immorality. You will do well to avoid these things.
- 11. Change the way we dress: cloth our self in God's holiness.
 - (1 John 2:16) For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world.
- 12. Change our actions: Begin with departing from our old habits and way of life. Proclaim to live a life according to God's will. Seek the will of God and honor the Lord. You then will see that God has gifted you with the good and perfect gifts and your spirit will rejoice in God our savior.
