

New Heart New Spirit

Main Bible Verse:

(Psalms 104:30) When you send your Spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the ground.

Summary:

1. New mindset will bring new motivation and power; New motivation brings new revelation and miracles.
2. God wants to help us to breakthrough bondage and darkness. He promises us, when we worship and pray, He will send His spirit to help us. With the work of the Holy Spirit, the new spirit will come upon us, we will be renewed, empowered, and receive the new direction.
3. Every day is Lord's day. We must daily lift up our hands to praise Him and to proclaim, to ask His new spirit to be upon us, so we may receive the new anointing and experience His new creation.
4. When God send His Spirit, all will be created. We must let the Holy Spirit change our hearts and to receive His anointing. When the Holy Spirit comes upon us, we will be able to depart from our weariness, illness, sadness, and fear, and enter the hope, peace, and joy of God.
5. When our heart is being renewed and changed by the Holy Spirit, we will be able to enter the new and living way. So we must daily call out to the Lord to fill us with His Holy Spirit.

v(Luke 4:18-19) "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

6. Jesus is the answer to all our problems. When the Holy Spirit came upon us, our poverty will be solved. Poverty is not merely monetary problems, but anything that we are not content with. That is why we must share the gospel to the poor. Which means we must all receive the instruction from God and all the bad news will become good news.
7. (John 1:1-4) Jesus came so we may be helped by the power of the gospel. For He is the lamb who crucified on the cross to atone our sins, so we will no longer be bound by sins. Sin brings sickness, curses, and bondage. Jesus is the word in the beginning and the word is with God, all things are created by Him and for Him. He is going to create everything for us and help us walk in His light. His light brings healing, brings life, and cast away all the darkness in us.
8. The power of the gospel is the promise of God. The more we share the gospel, the more power is on us. On the other hand, the more we are afraid, we are more vulnerable toward the steal, kill, and destroy from Satan.

v(Romans 11:25-27) I do not want you to be ignorant of this mystery, brothers and sisters, so that you may not be conceited: Israel has experienced a hardening in part until the full number of the Gentiles has come in, and in this way all Israel will be saved. As it is written: "The deliverer will come from Zion; he will turn godlessness away from Jacob. And this is my covenant with them when I take away their sins."

9. When does God make covenant with us? When we share the gospel and proclaim the good news. When does God take away our sins? When we proclaim the good news to others, when we pray for others, and when we believe in the power of the gospel. This is a great mystery that could only be unlocked when we share the gospel.
10. In 2021, let us all set out to share the gospel and proclaim the good news. Let us all experience that oppressed are set free and the blinds recovered their sight. When we believe, when we cry out, when we proclaim, God will let you hear Him, reveal his message to you, and let you see the way He has prepared for you.
11. We suffer because we walk astray ourselves. That is why Paul says we must dedicate our lives to the gospel. The power of the gospel is to give the poor a mystery. When we dedicate our lives to the gospel, we may all receive method and path of God.

12. When we forgive others, God will also forgive us. When the Spirit of God is upon us, our hearts will be created, and we will be empowered to forgive and to let go. When we submit ourselves to God and follow His instruction to forgive, we will be able to enter His new and living way.
13. God's word is power. Nothing is too hard for the Lord. Jesus came to set us free. He wants to become our strength and answer.

Captives Be Set Free

14. (Ezekiel 11:17-25) How could the captive be set free? (Ezekiel was a prophet of exile among the captives. Ezekiel was a priest, he prayed by the Kebar river for five years, the heaven was opened and he saw visions of God. The word of God came to him and became a prophet from a priest.) The method is to have an undivided heart, have a new spirit in us, rid of the heart of stone, and to have a heart of flesh.
15. Rid of the heart of stone is to get rid of the idols, arrogance, and unbelief. Rebuild the altar of worship and return to God. When our heart is undivided, when our heart is in the hands of God, and when our heart is returned to Christ, the Spirit of God will come down and give us a new vision.
16. We must have a heart that loves Jesus, loves our church, and a heart that never give up. With a heart of thanksgiving, work with the Holy Spirit and to work with the church and pray for the church.
17. The Spirit lifted Ezekiel up and brought him to the exiles in Babylonia in the vision given by the Spirit of God. Because God wanted to tell Ezekiel everything and to give him peace, and set His people free. When we truly repent and return, when we submit ourselves to God, the Spirit will lift us up, let us soar like eagles, give us all the good things, and reveal His plan to us.
18. When our spirit is not faint, when our spirit revives, the Spirit will lift us up and we will be able to receive the revelation of God and be set free.

King Jehoshaphat V.S. King Ahab (II Chronicles 18)

19. King Jehoshaphat and King Ahab were brothers in law. When King Ahab invited King Jehoshaphat to go into battle with him, King Jehoshaphat insisted on seeking the prophet of the Lord, but King Ahab refused to listen to God's revelation to prophet Micaiah.
20. King Ahab: While wearing a normal soldier's outfit, a random enemy soldier randomly shoots an arrow. The arrow struck King Ahab between the breastplate and the scale armor and he died.
21. King Jehoshaphat: While wearing the King's outfit that King Ahab tricked him to put on, the enemy army pursued him. King Jehoshaphat immediately call out to the Lord and the enemy army left him.
22. We must trust in God. When King Jehoshaphat trust in the Lord and call out to His name when he was in danger, he was saved, he safely returned to the palace in Jerusalem. When he called out to the Lord, the enemies turned away from him. He knew the word of God's prophet is God's anointing and the word of God. He knew the importance of humble before God and let God reign over our lives.

v(Proverbs 1:23) Repent at my rebuke! Then I will pour out my thoughts to you, I will make known to you my teachings.

23. When we hear the message, we must repent and return. Be still and wait for the Lord. Do not proceed until God gives us the go. When we receive the anointing, joy, and peace of the Lord, we must wait for the instruction of God. That is why Jesus told the disciples to wait in the Jerusalem and wait for the Holy Spirit.
24. When the power of the Holy Spirit came upon us, that is anointing. So we may be empowered to be His witness among all nations. The Holy Spirit is poured upon all flesh, to change our heart of stone into heart of flesh, heart of obedience and submission, heart of Christ. We then will receive dreams and visions from God, and we will receive prophecy to teach us all things.

25. (II Chronicles 19) When King Jehoshaphat returned to his palace in Jerusalem, prophet Jehu rebuked him on assisting King Ahab in battle. King Jehoshaphat immediately repented and sought the Lord.

26. It is easy to repent, to regret, but it is hard to change. We must have a new heart that is willing to change. The more we change, the more fragrance, the meekness, and the humility of the Christ we will have.

27. (II Chronicles 20) When the great army of three nations came attack King Jehoshaphat, he was afraid, but he set his mind to seek the Lord. He entered the temple and began to worship. He learned from his previous mistakes and was determined not to make a decision of their own again.

v(II Chronicles 20:20-22) Early in the morning they left for the Desert of Tekoa. As they set out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Listen to me, Judah and people of Jerusalem! Have faith in the Lord your God and you will be upheld; have faith in his prophets and you will be successful." After consulting the people, Jehoshaphat appointed men to sing to the Lord and to praise him for the splendor of his holiness as they went out at the head of the army, saying: "Give thanks to the Lord, for his love endures forever." As they began to sing and praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah, and they were defeated.

28. God sent Jahaziel to tell King Jehoshaphat not to be afraid for the battle is not his but God's. King Jehoshaphat immediately bow down and praise God. The appointed men to sing before the army. When they praise, the Lord set ambushes against their enemies and the enemy were defeated.

v(Acts 2:38) Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

29. The anointing is the Holy Spirit work on everyone. When we worship together, the anointing of the Holy Spirit will be upon us.

v(Amos 3:3) Do two walk together unless they have agreed to do so?

30. Agreed to do so means to follow God's instruction. When we follow God's way, we are walking with God, and he will fight the battles for us. God will reveal his mystery to His servants, we must return our heart to God. Do not focus on the earthly things, for all will be passed. But the Lord will reign forever.

31. Jesus will not forsaken us as orphans, He sent His Holy Spirit to teach us everything. Act according to God's word is to be united with God and to walk with him. Then all we do will be successful.
