Threefold Blessings

Main Bible Verse:

(Numbers 6:24-26) ""The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace."

Summary:

- 1. God is going to do new things in our family. When we long for the Lord and praise Him, He will fill us with His Holy Spirit. We must continue to daily read the bible, praise Him, and be filled with the Holy Spirit.
- 2. All the blessings are from God. He loves all of us and He wants to manifest Himself to us and to bless us for He is the trinity God. Numbers 6:24 is the blessing from the Father; Numbers 6:25 is the blessing from the Son; and Numbers 6:26 is the blessing from the Holy Spirit.
- 3. In Numbers chapter five, it specially taught us the importance of departing from our impurities, sanctifying ourselves, so we may belong to God and become His people. To be holy to the Lord.
- 4. (Matthew 16:24) How can we become Nazirites? How do I battle for the Kingdom of God? We must first overcome our own feelings. That is why Jesus taught the disciples to deny ourselves, carry the cross, and follow Him.
- 5. (I John 2:15-16) Depart from the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life. For if we love the world, the love for the Father in not in us. The lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of the life are from the world and will be perished, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.
- 6. In Numbers chapter 6, God told Moses to have Aron and his sons bless the Israelites. But before this could happen, in chapter 5, God told Moses to first get rid of all the impurities and set themselves apart for the Lord. Then we will be ready for the blessing of God.
- 7. (Psalms 16:2) Following God's instructions step by step, we will be ready for His blessings. That is why the scriptures taught us, apart from God, we have no good things. The trinity God is going to bless us and keep us, shine His face shine on us and be gracious to us, and he will turn His face toward us and give us peace.
- 8. The threefold blessing is the blessings from the Trinity God. Father will bless us and keep us, Son will shine His light upon us and be gracious to us, and the Holy Spirit will turn His face toward us and give us peace. We need to have the true peace from God, this peace could only be received from God.

First-fold: Blessings from the Father: Bless You and Keep You

- 9. (Ephesians 1:3-8) God's blessings are for His chosen people, those who were redeemed through Jesus' blood, and are willing to change and be renewed by God's word. God Himself will bestow His trinity blessings upon them through the Son Jesus Christ.
- 10. (Ephesians 1:22-23/John 17:11) Jesus Christ is the head of church, and the church is His body. We are all parts of His body and we must be filled with His Spirit. Christ the son gave His people Himself and all the blessings from heavenly realm. He loves us, and in the Name the Holy Father has given to Him, He will protect us.
- 11. (Psalms 121:8/John 17:15) The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore. God himself is protecting us from the evil one, and is watching over us, for we belong to Christ. No one could harm us.

Second-fold: Blessings from the Son: Be Gracious to You

12. (Luke 1:78) The prophecy of Zachariah told us, because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven. This is the Son comes to us and His light will shine on us. He will reveal Himself to us and let us enjoy His presence. This is such a great grace.

- 13. (John 16:8) Why would God shine His light upon us? So we may see our sins, thus repent and return before God. Only when we are able to see our own mistakes through the light of Christ, we will be able to change and offer a wonderful sacrifice to God, and enter God's great mercy and grace.
- 14. Only with the enlighten of the Holy Spirit, we will be able to see our arrogance, our self-righteousness, and our lacking.

Third-fold: Blessings from the Holy Spirit: Give You Peace

- 15. The Holy Spirit will give us true peace.
- 16. (Ephesians 4:30) The book of Ephesians taught us not to grieve the Holy Spirit. When we not grieve the Holy Spirit, He will turn His face toward us and to fill us with His peace and joy.
- 17. (Acts 9:30) When God shone His light on Saul on his way to Damascus, He turned His heart to Christ and changed from a person who persecuted Christians to Paul, the apostle who shared about Jesus to the nations. When he shares the good news of Jesus, the nations enjoyed a time of peace and was strengthened. All of them were blessed with a God fearing heart and was encouraged by the Holy Spirit, the churches increased in numbers.
- 18. v(Psalms 91:5-7) You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
- 19. The plague will not come "near" you. This is a command of God that no plague could come even close to you. Though the world is in distress, but God is protecting us and keep us safe, He is watching over us, nothing harm could come near us. This is the word of God and we should build our faith upon it.
- 20. (Psalms 33:9/Luke 1:37/II Corinthians 13:14) When God spoke, it came to be. He commanded, and it stood firm. No word from God will ever fail. We must read God's word and build our faith upon it. When we are weary, declare with God's word. For God has promised us, the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all.
