

The Kingdom of God Is in Your Heart

Main Bible Verse:

(Matthew 6:33) But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Summary:

1. In 2021, we should pray more, rely on God more, read the bible more, and share the gospel more. When we rely on God wholeheartedly, His miracles will manifest in our families and in our lives. We will see the new and living way God has created in our marriage, career, and health, for the glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house and the Holy Spirit will anoint all who seek Him.
2. (Matthew 6:33-34) Begin with not to worry. Jesus told us not to worry. "First seek" is to put God first, and always seek Him first before making any decisions. (Matthew 6:25-26) "His Kingdom" is the revelation, anointing, authority, and power. When we first seek His kingdom, all will be given to you.
3. There are three kinds of people:
 - a. Unbelievers.
 - b. Barely saved believers: They are baptized, but still walk on their own path. They follow the ways of the world. They occasionally go to church thinking it's enough to obtain the ticket to heaven. Their thought is like the rest of the world and couldn't receive the complete help of God. They lack strength and direction and got lost in their worry and bustle.
 - c. Overcomer: After receive salvation, they are willing to deny themselves and take up the cross, they long for God's word, eager to serve in the kingdom commission, and live a Godly life. They share the gospel to their families and friends and all those around them.
4. What is the kingdom of God? There is the physical Kingdom of Heaven in Revelation 21. The spiritual kingdom of heaven described in Matthew 13:44-46. In Luke 17:20-21, it talked about the kingdom in our heart.
5. (Hebrews 12:28) Pharisees focused on the kingdom that they could see. They asked Jesus and Jesus answered them, but they were unwilling to accept, for they only wanted what they desired, but couldn't see the savior Jesus Christ right in front of them. Their heart is filled with themselves, thus, could not receive the kingdom that cannot be shaken God prepared for us.
6. (Ruth 1:16-17) Ruth and Naomi had the kingdom that cannot be shaken in their heart. They did not look at their situation but followed God wholeheartedly, for they knew that the kingdom of God is most important. That is why Ruth said to her mother-in-law, "Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God. Where you die I will die, and there I will be buried. May the Lord deal with me, be it ever so severely, if even death separates you and me."
7. The more we seek God, the more mature our faith will be. The more we love God, the more we would understand the kingdom of God, and we will see the kingdom of God in us.
8. (Matthew 13:11-12) Our success depends on the kingdom and mystery of God. All the parables in the bible is true. They are the truth and the mystery of the kingdom of heaven. When we are willing to follow Jesus, make ourselves belong to God, and have the kingdom of God in us, we will be able to understand the revelation and wisdom in the parables. They are the mystery that we need and the direction in our lives.
9. (Matthew 13:12) Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them.

10. If we don't have Jesus as the light of our lives, if we lack the direction and method of God, as the scripture said, without the protection of God, we will lose what we thought that are ours, for they would be stolen by the world.
11. Whoever has will be given more. When the spirit of God is in us, when we seek God daily and ask His spirit to fill us, we will receive direction, for the Holy Spirit will teach us all things and put the kingdom of God in our heart. When our heart is not influenced by the world, we will see that all we have, is what God added on to us, is in God's protection. We will love God even more and be willing to follow Him, then the scriptures would become our blessings.
12. Paul knew the importance of being filled and guided by the Holy Spirit. (Acts 16:6-10) When God followed the guidance of the Holy Spirit, God strengthened his path for him. God bestow his miracles upon Paul and Silas in Macedonia. All the prisoners received the gospel. The jailer and his entire family were baptized and saved. (Acts 16:33)
13. (John 14:26) Do not follow our own feelings, experience, will, flesh, and desire, but seek the guidance of God. Pray, worship, and call out to God daily. When the Holy Spirit is upon us, we will be able to receive the revelation, wisdom, and anointing. Even for a little time, read the bible, let the word of God enlighten and help you, let the kingdom of God to be upon you.
14. When the word of God come to you, you must follow His guidance and act it out. Follow Jesus and trust in the Lord, effort into the kingdom of heaven.
