

Be God's Fellow Workers- God's Favor and Salvation Will Be Upon You

Main Bible Verse:

(II Corinthians 6:1-2) As God's co-workers we urge you not to receive God's grace in vain. For he says, "In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you." I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation.

Summary:

- When we have a new heart and new spirit, God will have us as His fellow workers. He will help us and bless us.
- God knows all the happenings in the end time, therefore He set up churches and sent the Holy Spirit to save us. No matter how the situation is, or how bad the pandemic is, as long as we are fellow workers of God, He is healing us. On top going to church meetings, we must learn to be the fellow workers of God, fellow Jesus and share the gospel, we will witness God's glory.
- (Mark 16:20) The disciples were sent, and gospel was shared. The Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it. We must set out and tell people that God is going to heal them and God is going to help with them. With our lips, share the gospel, and help them to receive the grace of God. (Mark 16:15)
- Remember, the thief came to steal, kill, and destroy, but the Holy Spirit came to give us peace, joy, and strength. The gospel is the power of God, it will fulfill God's work, it is not done by us, but by the power of the gospel.
- What type of miracles will be upon those who share the gospel? (Mark 16:16-18) Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well." When we work with God, all these authorities will be given to us.
- (Genesis 5:21-24) Enoch is the first person who worked with God. He longed for God, feared the Lord, and always called out to God.
- Enoch walked with God is working with God. Therefore, he was the first apostle and first prophet. When he walked with God, God revealed mysteries to him. (Jude 1:14-15) God has already told us about the judgement of the end-time and taught us how to face it. All these are recorded in the bible. God sent us His one and only Son, and taught us that Jesus is our way, truth, and life.
- Enoch walked with God and became a beautiful witness of God. He did not see death but was raptured to heaven. We must learn to walk and pray, and to ask God to enlighten us. Ask God to give us His word, and bless us with the hope of eternity.
- The second person who worked with God is Noah. Noah's name means the comforter during judgement. God let him know that the judgement is coming. He spent the days sharing the gospel when he was building the ark. (Genesis 6:13-17)
- The result of Noah working with God is that his entire family was saved. (Genesis 6:18)
- Noah was extremely obedient. Disregard of others' mocking, Noah was never discouraged, nor was he influenced by what the others say. He continued to do God's work every day of his life.
- Noah believed that all the word of God will be fulfilled, for God's word stands firm in heaven. God prepared for him all he needed for the judgement, for he was pleased with what Noah had done in Him.
- Ark is the churches today. God set up churches to help us in the judgement day. So we may be saved and protected.

- The ark was filled with God's anointing and aroma, so that all who are in the ark may be in quiet and trust. Inside the ark, there was no conflict nor confusion, but the glory of the Lord. All that are in the ark were protected and prospered. Therefore, we must not stop attending church meetings. For what is happening inside the ark is entirely different from the outside. Inside the ark, there is the ark of covenant, the presence of God, covered by the glorious cherubs. (Hebrews 9:4-5)
- The two stone tablets inside the ark of covenant is the laws and decrees for God's people to follow. When we listen to God's word and act upon it, when we do not stop attending church meetings, God's word will build us up. The light of God will rid of all darkness in our lives. God will provide you with the manna, the bread of life, from heaven, and make you soar like an eagle.
- The budding staff of Aaron is the power and authority of God. When we not receive God's grace in vain and pray for others, worship, help others to read the bible, help others with the word of God, and with our action respond to God's love. (Romans 3:23) Learn to forgive other's debts for God has forgiven us.
- Hezekiah lived a God fearing life. He worked with God. He was not afraid of the threat and harassment of others. When troubles come, he relied on God. He prayed in the sanctuary and put everything in God's hand. He did not rid of all his responsibilities God when he pray, but to stand firm before God and sought God's help. He prayed with prophet Isaiah until God's solution came to them. God's miracle was upon Hezekiah and his people, for God worked with him. (II Kings 19:14-17/Isaiah 37:1-2, 34-36)
- When Hezekiah was sick and almost died, he prayed to God. (II Kings 20:1-11) He ask for God's help that he had rid of the alters and the statues for the idols. He restored the worship in the sanctuary and helped God's people repent and return. We must do something for the Lord that is worthy of God's remembrance while we are on earth.

Conclusion:

Luke 10:17-20

Demons are sickness, disappointment, worries, burdens, anger, and arrogance...etc. When we share the gospel in Jesus name, the demons will leave whoever receives the gospel. God will make your sky fair and give you authority, and even more important, your name will be recorded in heaven. When you share the gospel according to God's plan and serve others, keep a pure heart like the infants before the Lord, you will be filled with the Holy Spirit. This is God's gift to all who work with Him.

(Luke 10:21) At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy Spirit, said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this is what you were pleased to do.
