

## For Everyone Who Asks Receives the One Who Seeks Finds

### **Main Bible Verse:**

v(Luke 11:9-13) "So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. "Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

### **Summary:**

#### Luke 11:9-13

- Jesus tells us that it is not that we did not receive but that we did not ask for it.
- He will give us a blessing that will never change.
  - To receive a blessing like this, we must ask for the Holy Spirit.
- Only the Holy Spirit will reveal everything to us.

#### Acts 1:4-8

- Once you receive the Holy Spirit and let go of the worldly things, whatever you ask for, God will give you.
- The Holy Spirit will come to change you and empower you with God's authority and wisdom.
  - We will be able to receive wisdom, revelations, and directions.
- It is not about the outward appearance, but the anointing and glory from God.

#### Psalm 66:16-20

- We must empty our hearts and repent before God.
  - God will listen to us after we do this.
  - He wants to give us greater blessing, so we must not cherish the sin in our hearts.
  - He is waiting for us to repent and return to him so that when we ask, we will receive, and when we knock, the doors will be opened.
- Our worship is because we love God.
- Why must we trust the Holy Spirit?
  - We have feelings that will skew our path.
- God will never forsake you, but it is that we have departed from God.

#### John 14:16-18

- Holy Spirit will come to teach us all things.
- We must rise up, pray, read the Bible, spread the gospel, and receive the Holy Spirit.
  - Peace and health will come to us.
  - We will overcome the impossibilities in our lives.
- Wherever the Spirit is, there is freedom.
- Those who love the Lord will not wait in vain.

#### Luke 11:5-8

- Jesus, as word became flesh, understands our weakness.
  - He came to help those in need.
  - We will, in the time of darkness, receive God's blessings and be satisfied.
    - We will have more abundant life.

- 3 things we will receive: Healing, Peace, Abundant blessings.
- We must worship in Spirit and in truth.
- We must be truthfully before both men and God.
- We must have no deceit in our hearts.
- We must love man and God.
