

Your Word Is a Lamp to My Feet and a Light to My Path

Main Bible Verse:

v(Psalms 119:105) Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

v(Acts 1:4-5) On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

Summary:

Acts 1:1-5

- The book of Acts is about the wonderful works of the Holy Spirit through disciples and apostles.
- Before Jesus was ascended, these chosen apostles were given instructions by the Holy Spirit to teach about the Holy Spirit.
- Our church is founded by Pastor Ku with God's word. With the instruction to teach about being filled with the Holy Spirit and to speak in tongues, to bring down the mysteries of the Kingdom of Heaven, with the commission and authority from heaven.

Revelation 1:20

- The seven lampstands are the churches.
- The seven stars in Jesus' right hand are the seven messengers. They are not only the angels in the church, but also the founder of the church. The founder of the church will be given instructions from God to give to the church.

Mark 16:16-17 | Romans 10:14 | Hebrews 11:1 | I Corinthians 2:9-11 | Psalms 119:105

- "Baptized" in the verse "whoever believes and is baptized will be saved", is not talking about water baptism, but the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- In order to believe, one must hear the word of God.
- New tongue is the language of the Holy Spirit. It is how the revelation is revealed to us.
- God reveals His revelation to us through His Spirit. Only when filled with the Holy Spirit, we will be able to receive the revelation of God.
- Before making any important decision, we must first receive the word of God, the instruction, through the Holy Spirit. That is why we must come to church, kneel down to praise and pray to God.
- We pray to receive direction and method from God, especially location.

I Corinthians 14:1-6

- When one prays in tongue, they edify themselves. When one prophesy, they edify the church.
- The prophetic preaching from the Holy Spirit strengthens, encourages, and comforts, through revelation or knowledge or prophecy or word of instruction.
- We come to church to seek the Lord to give us directions in our lives. To receive the revelation, the word of wisdom and knowledge from the Holy spirit, we must be filled with the Holy spirit and speak in tongue. This is following the way of love. It is eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy.
- When we speak in tongue:
 - It is not speaking to men, but to God. The enemy (the Satan) does not understand it.
 - It is utter mysteries in our spirit.
 - It gives us the wisdom, knowledge, and instruction.
 - We will receive power, revelation, anointing, and the authority from God to do things.

- We will be edified.

Isaiah 55:6-9 | John 14:6 | I Corinthians 1:17-31

- God's way is higher than our way, His thoughts higher than our thoughts.
- Jesus is our way, our truth, and our life.
- The message from the cross is the wisdom and power of God to save those who believe.
- Those who are perishing seek intelligence and knowledge of the world, but we preach Christ crucified, the wisdom and power of God.
- God chose the foolish thing of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong; God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are, so that no one may boast before him.
- It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

Hebrews 4:12-13 | Genesis 2:21-23

- The word of God is like a sharp double-edged sword that will solve our problems easily and safely. The word of God is precise, exact, and without any side-effects.
- The word of God is alive and active.
- When the word of God enters into our heart, we will be healed. This heal is instant.
- If we walk in our own ideas, in our own will, or in our flesh, we will never receive God's word and His wisdom.
- God is the first surgeon in the world that He operated on Adam. God took out Adam's bone and made Eve. That is why Adam called Eve "bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh."

John 4:7-24

- What God chose for us is the best. The spouse God has chosen for us is the best.
- The Samaritan woman was in suffering and grief. She had five husbands but none of them is right. Jesus came to her to help her. Jesus taught her to worship God in spirit and in truth.
- We must not commit adultery and we must not divorce.
- When we worship in spirit and in truth, God will guide us to the new and living way.

Matthew 6:12

- Jesus died on the cross for our sins. We must repent and return and keep ourselves away from sin.
- If we hate a person, it is like murder. We must not criticize or judge.
- The Lord's prayer taught us that we must forgive our debtors. We must learn to forgive from the heart through the help of the Holy Spirit.

I Corinthians 6:19

- The power of the Holy Spirit will help us with our addictions. Addictions to video game, alcohol, cigarettes, etc. Be addicted is being bound. We must repent before God and seek His forgiveness. He will forgive us and empower us through His Spirit. That is why we must cry out and ask God's help.
- Our body is a temple of God, we must take good care of it. Eat healthy, exercise, read the bible, and walk and pray until the light of God enters into us.

I Corinthians 14:14 | Psalms 139:13-14 、 17 | Proverbs 20:27

- When we pray in tongue, we pray in spirit, and our mind is unfruitful.
- Mind is our own feelings, our own thinking, and our own ideas.

- When we pray in tongue, we pray that the Holy Spirit may reign in us and our mind will be unfruitful. Then the Holy Spirit will teach us to do all things.
- King David told us how precious are the thoughts of God. The thoughts of God will solve all our problems.
- Our biggest battle is right in our head. That is why Jesus taught us to deny ourselves, take up the cross, and follow Jesus.
- Deny ourselves is not to rely on our own feelings and understanding, but to follow the way of Jesus, for Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life.

Joshua 1:1-9 | Joshua 5:13-15

- God taught Joshua to be strong and courageous. But be careful to obey all the law that Moses gave him.
- Joshua's success is that he follows all the laws of God that Moses has given him. That is why God was with him.
- Joshua met the commander of the army of the Lord, Jesus. Jesus gave him a vision, a plan, a direction.
- Joshua met Jesus when he was praying in the morning. We must attend morning prayer meetings to pray and worship and to seek God's way.
- When Joshua met Jesus, he fell facedown to the ground in reverence and asked, "What message does my Lord have for his servant?"
- Jesus taught Joshua to take off his sandal for the place where you are standing is holy.
 - Sandal is our own way of doing things, our own thinking.

Genesis 39-41

- We must never lose hope but continue to pray.
- Joseph went through a lot of hardships. But he never stopped to love God and to follow God's way.
- Joseph was sold, falsely accused, and forgotten by men, but God was with him.
- God blessed him with His wisdom and revelation and lifted Joseph up.
- Joseph knew very clearly that the interpretation of the dream is not from him but from God, and the purpose of them is to help the people.
- Be patient and persevere. Share the gospel, for the gospel is the power of God.
- Deny ourselves, take up the cross, and follow Jesus. Share the gospel. God will prepare everything for us.
- In these last days, nothing is more important than people being saved.

John 14:1-2 | Romans 8:26 | Psalms 8:2

- When we are weary and don't know how to pray, we must pray in tongue. When praying in tongue, the Holy spirit will intercede and help us to pray.
- When we are praying in tongue, it is to silence the foe and avengers. Things will change, difficulties will turn into God's miracles, hardships will turn into God's glory, and emptiness will turn into God's fulfillment.
