He Has Risen

Main Bible Verse:

v(Luke 24:1-8) On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'" Then they remembered his words.

Because of Christ's resurrection, we have 100% assurance of the hope of eternal life.

- Our sins our forgiven because Jesus has risen from the dead.
- We can rely on God by calling out to him.
- We have the gift of everlasting life.
- We can live life with the power of resurrection in us.
 - This power is the Holy Spirit.
 - The Holy Spirit will give us power and direction.

Luke 24:1-8 He is not here. He has risen.

- Jesus is not inside the tomb because He has already risen.
- Jesus is the living God.
- Our faith must rest on the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
 - o Jesus died on the cross and resurrected after 3 days for our sake.
 - God will give us the power of resurrection.
- Jesus has truly risen, and He has given us the hope of resurrection
 - Because Jesus lives,
 - We can live outside of fear.
 - We have assurance of our futures.
- Every day we can always see that Jesus is there with us.
 - He will answer our prayers.
 - We can know deep in our hearts, through our every day, that Jesus has resurrected and has given us the resurrection power.

Hebrews 9:11-12 Our sins are forgiven.

- The blood of Jesus redeems us of our sins.
 - His blood is atonement for us.
- Jesus sacrificed himself as a sacrificial lamb for all of us.

- The Father approved of Jesus to die and shed His blood for us.
 - Jesus' blood is the only thing that can cleanse our sins and make us whole again.
- We will not have the condemnation and guilty feeling in our hearts.
 - We must ask God to forgive our sins.
 - Jesus' blood will wash us clean and we will be forgiven.
 - o We will be able to approach God and pray to him knowing that he will help us.
- Jesus died for everyone no matter what sins they have committed.
 - There is no worse sin or lighter sin; it is all sin.
 - o No matter what you have done, you must come before God and repent and return.
- We must proclaim that God is our God, and we must repent and return.
- We must come back into God's presence.
- Without Jesus, there is no world.
 - Without God we cannot do anything.
- Without repentance, our lives will be very dangerous.
- God is patient and will wait for you to come back to Him.
- Revelation 21:8
 - o The result of unrepentance and unbelieving.

John 11:21-26 We will live and never die.

- Jesus is the resurrection and the life.
- The ones who believe in Jesus will live even though they die.
- Those who love and serve God, when they die, their spirit will be with God.
- 1 Corinthians 15:55-58
 - Jesus has already defeated death.
 - Death has no victory at all.
 - o For the believers in Jesus, He has already defeated death for us.
 - We will fall asleep; absent from the body, present with the Lord.
- We must not let our mourning take over us.
 - We must believe that our loved ones are with God though they are absent from their body.
- We must share the gospel and share the gift of everlasting life with those around us.

John 14:16-17 He lives in us.

- The power of the resurrection spirit is in us.
- God lives in us through the means of the Holy Spirit.
- Those who believe in God, Jesus asked God to send the Holy Spirit to them to help them and give them power.
- We must praise God and pray to God daily.
- When you are in trouble, pray to God.

- Jesus is our way, truth, and life.
- o He will help us and give us our direction.

Romans 8:11

- o "And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you."
- o The Holy Spirit is who raised Jesus from the dead.
 - This Spirit also resides in our hearts.
 - It will give life to our mortal bodies.
- We must let our hearts and our minds to come alive.
 - We must believe that through God, even dry bones will come alive.
- Nothing is impossible for God.
- Do not underestimate the power of resurrection from God.
- The dead will come alive again, our sickness will be healed.
- Jesus has already taken the curses for us.
- He is now sitting next to God and making our way for us.
- Because Jesus lives, we do not need to worry and fear, but we can enjoy the power of resurrection.
