

The Divine Power and Authority of Speaking in Tongues

Main Bible Verse:

(Mark 16:16) Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Summary:

Mark 16:16-18 | John 10:10 | Psalms 8:2 | Job 26:13 | John 14:1 | I Corinthians 14:18

- Unbelievers will be condemned.
 - If you are being condemned, no matter how much you serve God, it will not be counted.
- Church is a place of God's presence.
 - Church is a place where you will be set free.
 - When you come to church you must have 100% thorough faith.
- Whoever believes, these signs will accompany them:
 - In God's name, drive out demons, demons are the thieves. (John 10:10)
 - Demons of doubt, adultery, fear, hypocrisy, arrogance, and more; all are casted away in Jesus' name.
 - Thief comes to steal, kill, and destroy so we must come to church on Sundays to meet God, to pray in tongue, and to encounter miracles.
 - Speak in new tongue. (Psalms 8:2 | John 14:1 | I Corinthians 14:18)
 - From the lips of children and infants in old testament is the same as speaking tongues as Jesus said.
 - Speaking in tongue is to have the ordained praise.
 - The ordained praise can silence the foe and avengers.
 - Bible teaches us how to destroy Satan's schemes. Those who pray in tongue daily will not fear because they have ordained praise (spiritual power).
 - Pray in tongue will bring the ordained praise. Demons of worries will be gone and the power of God will enter us.
 - Doctors cannot heal our worries. The only way to heal our worries is to pray in tongue.
 - Our hands can pick up snakes. (Job 26:13)
 - Lay hand on our heads and get rid of the snakes.
 - There are snakes in the sky above us. The way to get rid of those snakes is to come to church and to pray. Also we can come out to be laid hand when the pastor is praying for us.
 - If we unknowingly or unintentionally drink any poisons, nothing can harm us.
- We must come to church to meet God every Sunday.
 - We must come to church to speak in tongues and to receive revelations.
 - Missing one assembly will cut your authority of prayer in half.

1 Corinthians 14:1-3 | I Corinthians 14:18

- What is "following the way of love"
 - It is not to love others with our feelings.

- It is to speak in tongues.
- It is to desire the spiritual gifts. Especially prophecy.
- Following the way of love is to speak in tongue, receive the spiritual gifts at church, and also gift of prophecy.
- What is the reason for speaking in tongues?
 - It is to receive the mysteries from the Lord.
- That is why Paul thanked God that he prayed in tongues more than everyone else.

Luke 17:14-19

- A heart of thanksgiving is faith.
 - To the leper who came back, praised God in a loud voice, and threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked Him after he was healed, Jesus said, "Your faith has made you well."
 - Those with thanksgiving when they receive blessings, are those who are healed and also saved.

John 4:23-29

- The word of God will create our future.
 - Jesus taught the Samaritan woman to worship in spirit and in truth.
 - When the Samaritan woman heard Jesus, she put down her water jar. She understood that what she needed was not water, but the word of God. She knew that she was saved, because the Holy Spirit revealed everything to her.

Matthew 16:16-19

- The rock is not Peter. The rock is the church in Christ.
 - Church has the power and authority, is from the kingdom of heaven.
 - Peter received the keys of kingdom of heaven. The keys of kingdom of heaven can: whatever is bound on earth it will be bound in heaven; whatever is loosed on earth, it will be loosed in heaven.
 - Through the authority of church, people will receive spiritual gifts.
 - However, if we receive gifts and blessings without a heart of thanksgiving, it will be taken away.
- We must not abuse the authority that God has given us.
 - Only use the kingdom authority for the kingdom commission and not for personal gain.
- We must drive out demons and speak in new tongues.
 - This is the reason why God has given us authority.
 - God give us spiritual gifts to drive out demons and to pray for others.
 - When we have these spiritual gifts, we must glorify God with thanksgiving faith.
