Main Bible Verse:

(John 18:6) "I am He," Jesus said. When Jesus said, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground.

Summary:

John 18:5-6 | Luke 22:51

- We have a lot of negativity and feelings, but Jesus does not.
 - \circ $\;$ He has the Holy Spirit, and He is the word.
 - Jesus came to earth to spread the word of God.
 - \circ $\;$ When we receive and act upon the word, we will have miracles.
 - We must let the word of God be our way.
 - When Jesus says, "I am He," our negativity will be taken away from us.
- Then Simon Peter, who had a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, cutting off his right ear. Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given me?" Jesus then picked up the ear and healed the man for He is the word, the miracles, and the Spirit.
- We must lift our hands daily and have interactions with God.
 - \circ ~ We must let our lives have a connection with the word, and it will be our direction.
- Our feelings may not be correct. Even if it is, we must wait for the commission from God.
 - \circ $\;$ The commission God gives us will bring us life.

John 10:10

- The thief will come to steal, kill, and destroy, and all of this is the work of Satan.
- Jesus, on the other hand, is the creation, the anointing, and the revelation. Therefore, we must receive God's revelation with us.
 - We must always let the revelation of God guide us.
- It is not how we look, but how we live our lives.
 - Nothing is more important than how our lives are in the eyes of God.
 - That is why Jesus said, "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."
 - We must live a life that is pleasing to God.

Ephesians 6:1-4

- We must honor our father and mother.
- This is the commandment has a promise.
 - Following this commandment will bring us blessings.
 - Without following the commandment, we will not be able to receive the promise God has given us.
- This commandment cannot be changed no matter what.
- Everything in our lives will be affected by the God's promise for us.

1 Corinthians 13:4-8

- How can we have God create love for us?
 - We must have God's "I am He" get rid of our own will and negativity.
 - Love is patient. When we have this patient, it will bring out kindness.
 - When we do have the patience and kindness, our own feelings and human will, will be changed by Jesus' "I am He."
- For a married couple to receive such promises they must:
 - 1. Continuously be patient
 - 2. Continuously be kind
 - 3. Continuously love each other
- It is important to have this commandment with a promise to be in our marriage and family.
- We must use God's love as a determination to change our own lives to manifest God's love in the people around us.
- How we love, is directly proportional to our blessings.
- We must come to church to meet God and receive His word.

 - Once we receive this, God's creation will be in our life.
 - This is a commandment with a promise.
 - We must fix our eyes on Jesus to receive this commandment with a promise when we come to church.
 - \circ The way to receive the promise from the commandment, we must honor our parents.
 - We must speak to our parents with:
 - 1. A gentle voice
 - 2. A smile on our face

 - We must change our hearts and be willing to lift our hands to pray and honor our parents. When we do so, we will receive strength and power from God.
