1 Corinthians 9:26-27 | 2 Samuel 5:17-25

- Whatever God wants you to do, He will prepare for you.
 - o Whatever you decide to do by yourself, you must prepare for yourself.
 - We must only do that which God has told us to do.
- It is not what we know how to do, but what God has told us to do.
 - o God will plan everything out for us if he wants us to do it.
- We must set our destination at where God wants us to go.
 - We must run in the direction God wants us to go, or we will be running aimlessly.
 - o The direction that God gives us is 100% successful.
- We must have faith in God's direction for us.
 - When our faith is great, everything God wants to give us, we will receive.
 - Jesus is the author and perfector of our faith.
 - He will recreate our lives for us.
- Without God, we cannot do anything, but with Him, we will be able to do all things.
 - o We must kneel down, confess our sins, and return to God.
- When we come across many hindrances and obstacles while we are doing things, we must repent and return to God, and receive new revelation from God.
- All of the decision making and planning we do in our lives must start with prayer.
 - We need to ask God what we need to do and how we need to do it.
 - Our prayer is to receive God's direction for us.
- God wants us to see our direction very clearly.
- God really enjoys seeing us get healed and blessed.
 - We must remove all of our doubts, and we will receive what God wants to give us.
- David inquired of God, and that is where his success came from.
 - We must learn to always ask God before we do anything, and we will have success.
 - Without God's permission and directions, whatever we do will be futile.
 - o Therefore, David said, "As waters break out, the Lord has broken out against my enemies before me."
 - Even the second time when the Philistines attacked, David once again inquired of God.
 - He received the instructions to, "Do not go straight up, but circle around behind them and attack them in front of the poplar trees. As soon as you hear the sound of marching in the tops of the poplar trees, move quickly, because that will mean the Lord has gone out in front of you to strike the Philistine army." from God.
- We do not do what we see others do and we do not run when we see others run.

- We must let God make the decision for what we do and where we run for it is He who opens the path to success.
- We come to church to inquire of God, and He will teach us how to do everything.
- We must learn to kneel down and pray to receive the 100% success from God.
 - He is our direction and our strength.

Luke 23:34 | Matthew 9:20-22

- Jesus' first statement while dying on the cross was, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."
 - o In this statement, He meant that they were not aware of their direction and their way.
 - Only God knows the best way to bring us to victory.
 - It is not by our own success, but it is what God wants us to do that leads to success.

John 14:6

- Jesus already promised that He would be our way, truth, and life.
 - Way is our direction
 - Truth is our method
 - And the life is our complete health
 - When we have God's direction and method, we will receive this life.
- When our worship touches the Holy Spirit, we will be healed just like the woman who had been subjected to bleeding.
 - We must have faith like the woman who believed that as long as she had just touched the edge of Jesus' cloak, she would be healed.

John 10:10

- We must not have doubt in what God gives us, for this is what the thief wants.
 - Doubt is the disturbance and interference from satan that will cause us not to receive.
 - When we believe without doubt, satan will flee.
 - Our faith and repentance are what brings us God's healing and blessings, so we should not have any doubts in us.
 - How much faith we have is how much we will receive of God's healing and blessings.
- God wants to give us visions to see our direction, and He wants to heal us as long as we have faith without doubt.
- With 100% faith, we must let Jesus, the author and perfector of faith, heal us.
- We must always go to church with full faith and repentance to go before God and let his "I am He" come to us.
