Main Bible Verse:

(Psalms 93:1-2) The Lord reigns, he is robed in majesty; the Lord is robed in majesty and armed with strength; indeed, the world is established, firm and secure. Your throne was established long ago; you are from all eternity.

Summary:

Psalms 93:1-2 | Matthew 6:12 | Isaiah 61:3

- When we come to church the most important part is to meet with God.
 - o Church meetings are for us to come and receive power, so we must not miss any of these meetings.
 - o To receive God's cloak of power, we must come to church.
 - Church will help teach us how to receive God's cloak of power.
- When the Lord reigns, His robe is majestic and of power.
 - When we worship and praise in truth, angels will cloak us with the robe of worship, and nobody will dare touch us.
- We must not become like those who do not praise until they have problems, but we must permanently wear the robe of worship and praise God.
- When we come to church we must lift up our hands and praise God, He will reign over our house and watch over us.
 - o God will establish His throne in our house.
 - He will be in our house robed in majesty and power.
- When we meet problems, we must lift up our hands and call out to God.
 - We must ask for God's power and healing to come upon us.
 - Once we pray, we must not worry and have faith in God.
- We do not have power; however, God has power.
 - When we come to church and call out to Him, we will receive revelation, healings, and the strength to forgive our debtors.
- If we want God to forgive our debts, we must also forgive other people's debts.
 - We must always forgive others' debts regardless of what happens.
 - o There are 3 kinds of debts:
 - Financial
 - Relationship
 - Career

Psalms 91:9

- We must take God as our refuge.
 - We must cry out and proclaim that God is our refuge.
 - When we take God as our refuge, He will help us with what we need.
 - We will receive His power and instruction.
 - o No matter what we encounter, we must not worry and call out to God to receive power.
- The church is the refuge of God, so we must come to church to meet God.
- We must let God minister everything in our lives.

John 10:10 | Hebrews 12:1-2

- The thief will first come to steal, kill, and destroy our mindset, but Jesus will help us to receive power when this happens.
 - God will come to give us His power and hope.
 - We will enter into His abundant life.
 - The way to receive His life, peace, and joy is to come to church.
 - We must also not forget to forgive others.
 - This is why the Lord's prayer teaches us the importance of forgiving others' debts.
 - When we forgive others, not only will God also forgive our debts, He will also lead us away from temptations.
- We must not live within the thief's stealing, killing, and destroying, but come to church to praise God and receive His anointing.
 - We must live in faith.
 - o God will take away our worries and give us peace.
 - o God comes to give us life, and when He does, all of our problems will be solved for us.
 - o God will always warn us ahead of time, and we must listen to Him.
- When we let God reign over our lives, business, and marriage the thief will not be able to come to steal, kill, and destroy.
- Church is the place to meet God and receive miracles through worship.
 - o God will help us depart from our sins and debts, and He will also take away our burdens.
 - o God will give us the strength to move forward, and He will speak to us.
 - o The instructions we receive through God's word will be His power coming upon us and solving our problems.
- Sickness is not from God.
- We must give our burdens to God, and He will give us comfort and peace.
 - He will robe us with His power and strength.
 - We must lift up our hands to worship and pray both at home and at church and give our burdens to God.
 - When we come to church, we must not continue to carry our burdens, but give it all to God.
- To have God's power, we must first have full faith.
 - God is the author and perfector of our faith, so we must not have any doubts.
 - o This faith is from Jesus, and in order to receive it, we must call out to God and let go of our burdens.
 - We must know that God will help always help us.
 - God will listen and answer to our prayers, and He will come to give us life.
 - As long as we ask for God's help all of our problems will be solved.
- Faith is calling out and inquiring of God until we receive His instructions.
 - We must only act after we receive His word.
 - o Before we do anything, we must inquire of God first.
 - We must pray until God's word comes to us and tells us what to do.

John 18:6

- When we fall before God, His healing will come upon us.
 - The 30 seconds that we fall before God is the time that the Holy Spirit is at work.
 - o We must have full faith and no doubts, and we will receive His healing.

- Angels will come and touch us, and we will be well.
- God does not like it when we are sick.
- The way to not get sick again after we are healed is to rid ourselves of thoughts from satan in our hearts.
 - o We only have Jesus in our hearts.
 - o When we give glory to God with thanksgiving and praise, we will receive complete healing.

Friendly Reminder from the Pastor:

- During the end time, when disease is spreading, we must keep ourselves at home to read the Bible.
- We must refrain from going about, but to focus on bringing people to Jesus.
- Jesus is coming again soon, so we must prepare and be ready.
- We must have our hearts cleansed by wholeheartedly attending the holy communion, worshiping in spirit and in truth, and spreading the love of God to others.
