 - We must willingly come before the Lord and pour our soul to Him when we pray.
- Hannah had wholehearted prayer.
 - Eli misunderstood Hannah's prayer for being drunk.
 - When we pray in tongues, people may not understand and find us weird.

Psalms 8:2

- 3 traits of words of children and infants:
 - They speak in their own words with all their effort
 - They silence the foes and avengers
 - They cannot do anything
 - We cannot do anything, but God is almighty and can do anything for us.
- The words from the lips of children and infants are regarding to speaking in tongues.
 - Speaking in tongues is very precious, so we should speak in tongues more.
 - We must hike up to the hills and pray while walking..
- Our success comes when we speak in tongues, God's word comes upon us, and the foes and avengers are silenced.

1 Corinthians 14:1-2 | Exodus 17:5-6

- Speaking in tongues is speaking to God and not to other people.
 - What we speak is mysteries of God.
 - Only God will understand.
 - We can only do this when we humble ourselves before God and pray wholeheartedly.
 - We must also have a heart of repentance.
- We do not know what is going to happen, so we must speak in tongues.
 - Speaking in tongues is following the way of love.
 - Following the way of love is speaking in tongues to God.
 - We must learn to humble ourselves to repent and return before God and speak in tongues that can silence the foes and avengers.
 - Our future, marriage, and health are dependent on the word from God that we receive while praying in tongues.
- God liked Moses because he followed all of His instructions.
 - When Moses followed God's instruction water flowed from the rock.
- God is our creator, and we must remember to pray when we encounter obstacles.
 - We must pray for God to refine us and to strengthen us so we may lift up our hands to repent and return and to be unaffected by our environment.
