Main Bible Verse:

(Luke 17:17-19) Jesus asked, “Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?” Then he said to him, “Rise and go; your faith has made you well.”

Summary:

Matthew 24:21-22 | Mark 16:17 | Psalms 8:2

- The “great distress” is covid-19
- This “great distress” will be unequalled from the beginning of the world until now—and never to be equaled again.
- Due to the elect, the days of the “great distress” will be cut short
- The great calamity is now, but we do not have to be afraid.
 - We just need to become the elect and receive God’s authority
- To receive God’s authority, we must:
 - We must, in the name of Jesus, drive out demons.
 - Regardless of what we encounter, we must pray for ourselves.
 - We must pray until the demons leave us.
 - If we want miracles we must speak in such a way.
 - God gives us authority, so we need not be afraid.
 - We must speak in *new* tongues.
 - Speaking in new tongues is not just making sound, but by speaking in sentences.
 - This means that from the lips of infants and children silence the foes and avengers.
 - This is speaking in tongues.
 - We must go up to the mountain, pray, and speak in tongues.
 - This is the method for overcoming covid.
 - We must read the Bible, pray while walking, keep good hygiene, and continue to go to church meetings.
 - Pick up snakes with our hands
 - When we drink deadly poison, it will not hurt us at all
 - Place hands on sick people and they will get well

Matthew 11:28 | Psalms 103:19 | Hebrews 1:14 | Psalms 119:89

- We must come before God with faith, to trust in God’s word.
 - When we do, we will receive peace.
- In order to enter into miracles, we must trust that Jesus rules over all things, and everything is in the hands of Jesus.
 - We must come before God, kneel down, and repent and return.
 - When we get back up, we must follow the instructions God gives us.
 - If we want to have miracles, we must just go before Jesus.
 - We can put our burdens before Jesus.
- We must not take coming to church, worshiping God, and reading the Bible lightly.
- In distress we will meet miracles as long as we have prayer upon prayer.
 - God has already sent angels to protect us; His word stands firm in the heavens and gives us strength.

- We must pray continually and put God as our first priority.

Luke 17:11-19 | 1 Corinthians 14:18

- 2 important points in the story of the 10 lepers:
 - Go show yourself to the priests
 - This is a test of the lepers' faith
 - The lepers had faith that God had already healed them and that they would be clean.
 - Having leprosy during this time would result in being quarantined outside of the city.
 - We must have faith like this.
 - Praise God in a long voice
 - When we loudly praise and proclaim before God, we will have miracles and the power of God.
 - As long as we dare to go before Jesus, he will definitely heal us.
 - We must also be like the one who had a thanksgiving heart, and praise God in a loud voice.
 - The devil is most afraid of our praising and proclaiming loudly, but God is the most pleased when we do this.
 - The more problems we encounter, the more we must pray and proclaim loudly and speak in tongues.
 - This is why Paul said, "I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you."
 - When we praise God in a loud voice, God's word will come upon us and help us.
 - God will help us to rid ourselves of worries and give us His instructions.

Romans 10:13-15

- Paul taught us that we must loudly call on the name of God.
 - Wherever God sends us, everything will go well.
 - All of our worries and problems will be taken away.
 - As long as we have faith we will be healed.
- When we fall before Jesus, we must have an empty heart and humility to receive the instructions from God.
 - God will open up a new and living way for us.
