Summary:

Matthew 24:21-22

- There is a great distress which is Covid-19.
- Being raptured can help avoid being subjected to the calamities.
- Whatever man cannot do God can do.
 - God can do anything for us.
- To get rid of all the dread caused by Covid-19 we must worship in spirit and in truth.
 - o Those who worship in spirit and in truth will have power.
- When our spirit touches the Holy Spirit, we will be purified of anything related to Covid-19.
 - The Holy Spirit can help us to solve all of our problems.

Matthew 21:12-13 | Luke 23:34 | Matthew 6:12

- Jesus freed all the sacrificial animals to show that His sacrifice was enough for the rest of time.
 - o Jesus sacrificed Himself for the atonement of man.
 - Our perfect peace comes from Jesus' sacrifice for us.
 - Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."
 - o From then on we do not need to sacrifice lambs or calves because Jesus already shed His blood for us.
 - o Jesus' blood will cover all who worship in spirit and in truth.
- Church is a place where we come to worship God in spirit and in truth.
 - When we do so, the Holy Spirit will descend upon us, and we will receive God's anointing and the strength to forgive others.
- The greatest benefit of being a Christian is that we can forgive.
 - However much we forgive and bless others, Jesus will forgive and bless us.
- We must lift up our hands and worship as an offering to God.

John 18:6 | Matthew 26:51-52 | Luke 22: 50-51

- We must fall before Jesus' "I am He," and Jesus will heal us.
 - We must have faith without doubt, and He will heal us completely.
- Church is the place where Jesus will perform miracles, so we must have a heart to let Jesus renew us.
- Jesus healed the priest's servant's ear, and He will definitely heal us.

1 Corinthians 9:26-27

- We must not do things aimlessly, but we must get our aim from God.
 - We must not do things by our own will but do everything by God's way.
- When Jesus' "I am He" enters us we will receive His direction for us, and we must not let our feelings get in the way of Jesus' way and method for us.
- When we bring people to church, we must not only bring them, but we must make sure that they take Jesus as their way, truth, and life.

Luke 17:14-19

- What does it mean "Your faith has made you well"?
 - o It means that by faith we have prayed, so God will bestow His healings and blessings upon us.
 - o When we receive His blessings, we must return to church and give thanks to God.
- The faith mentioned is the faith of thanksgiving.
 - We must never stop worshiping in spirit and in truth no matter where we go.

Matthew 16:26 | John 14:6 | Matthew 16:24

- Jesus told us that life is more valuable than the whole world.
- The most important thing is that we come to church and bring our family and friends with us.
- God is truly pleased by our lives, so we must keep coming to church.
 - We must take Jesus as our way, truth, and life, and everything we do will be blessed.
 - o Jesus wants to give us life, so we must not be afraid to deny ourselves, take up the cross, and follow Jesus.
 - This is the only way for Him to become our way, truth, and life, and we will receive His abundant life of rapture.
- Nothing can be exchanged for a life.
- In order to keep our blessings and healings, we must read Bible for at least an hour a day.
