Main Bible Verse:

(Matthew 11:28-30) "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

Summary:

Matthew 16:21 | 2 Samuel 5:19-25

- Especially during the end times, we must pray until the Holy Spirit is with us, and when we do, everything we do will prosper.
- As long as we have the presence of the Holy Spirit, all of our problems will be solved.
- It is permissible that we go places, but we must first inquire of God.
- How can David always have victory in battle?
 - He always inquired of the Lord, and only did things when God told him to.
- In everything we do, we must inquire of the Lord, and we will have success just like David.
- When we inquire of God, we must wait patiently with a heart of reverence until He gives us our direction.
 - God will give us very detailed instructions for what we need to do, and we must only do things after we have received this instruction.

Genesis 3:19 | John 10:10

- We must pray continually until we receive the instruction from God.
- Why must we inquire of God?
 - God wants to teach us everything because He wants us to be successful.
- The thief comes to steal, kill, and destroy our peace, thoughts, and blessing, but we must have the presence of the Holy Spirit with us to overcome it.
- The success of a Christian comes from inquiring of the Lord.
 - We must read the Bible daily so we can inquire of the Lord.
 - When we inquire of God, He will give us mysteries and the key to our success.
- God will tell us where we need to be and what we need to do.
- We must wait for the commission and vision from God.
- We must have a healthy body.
 - Jesus suffered wounds and shed His blood for us to have health and peace.
 - We must pray before every meal, keep ourselves clean, and exercise daily.
 - After we exercise, we must read the Bible.
- Our purpose for coming to church is to worship.
 - The meaning of our worship is to have a connection to God in spirit and in truth.
- No matter how little of things we are going to do, we must inquire of God.
- We must not only come to church, but we must implement everything that we learn and receive from God into our lives.

John 18:6 | Matthew 11:29-30

- We must come before God and put all of our problems and burdens before him.

- We must not only listen to God's word, but we must listen to it, receive it, and act upon God's word.
 - When we do this God's word will create miracles for our lives.
- God wants to give us miracles in our lives.
- Jesus taught us to be humble and meek.
 - God does not want us to have burdens and weariness.
 - Whenever we come to church we must worship in spirit and in truth, and we will receive peace.
- Everything we do must be done for God.
 - The more we do for God the more we will prosper.
- When we rely on God we will receive His miracles.
