Main Bible Verse:

(James 1:2-8) Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. 8 Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do.

- We have the promise of God, and it will never fail.

 - His wisdom is limitless unlike man's wisdom.
- With God's wisdom we will lack nothing.

- Phillip followed his own wisdom, but Andrew had faith in God's wisdom.
 - Andrew had faith that Jesus could do anything.
- Andrew's faith allowed for over five thousand people to be fed.
- God knows what is best for us, so we must entrust everything to Him.
- The moment we believe in God, we are in the hands of Jesus.
 - We become His vessel, and we will live every day by grace.
- God will do wonderful works in our life, and we will rejoice and be glad in it.
- When we meet troubles we must persevere and follow the way that God taught us.
 - "Because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope."
 - The character here means that we are mature and lack nothing.
 - We must know that Jesus comes to give us abundant life unlike Satan who comes to steal, kill, and destroy.
 - We do not need to be afraid of Satan because of the life God has given us.
- Joseph entrusted everything to God and knew that He was the one doing everything for him.
 - By entrusting everything to God, he had much success.
- We must persevere even when others are mean to us.
- God will pour His love into us to create miracles in our life.
- Even when we feel that things are impossible, God can do anything for us.

 - When we speak in tongues the foes and avengers will be silenced.
- When we pray in tongues, we are following the way of love.
 - We must eagerly desire spiritual gifts upon following the way of love.
- Speaking in tongues is not to man but to God.
 - Nobody except God will be able to understand.
 - We will be able to receive all sorts of mysteries.
- God knows that we do not know what we must do, and He will help give us our direction.
 - Through the cross and Jesus' blood, the mysteries of God will be revealed in our heart.
 - Everything we experience is great blessings from God.
 - Whatever God has prepared for us is greater than we can fathom.
