

Jesus is Our Shepherd and the Gate for the Sheep

Main Bible Verse:

(John 10:7) Therefore Jesus said again, "Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep.

Summary:

John 10:7 | Psalms 23:1-6

- Jesus is our gate, and this gate is the way to our health and success.
 - We must enter this gate, and God will give us success.
 - Our success will be our commission.
- Jesus comes to fulfill Psalms 23 as our shepherd.
 - The key is to follow Jesus.
 - When we follow Jesus, He will be our shepherd and we will not lack or struggle.
- Our only issue is that we do not know that Jesus is our shepherd.
- We come to church not for people but for Jesus because He is our shepherd.
- John 10 is the answer to Psalms 23.
 - Psalms 23 tells us that God wants the best for us without worries and struggles, so that is why we must worship and pray at least 3 times a day.
 - In the morning, afternoon, and evening.
 - This is the way to refresh our spirit.
- Whenever we encounter problems, all we need to do is lift up our hands and ask God for help.
 - Through singing and praising, we can ask for God's help, and He will solve our problems.
 - We must let our heads be anointed through praise, and all our enemies will flee.
- Everyone who enters through Jesus will be saved.
 - Everything of ours will blossom into success, and all of our problems will be answered.
 - This is why we need to learn to worship in spirit and in truth.
- To worship is to receive faith.
 - When we have faith in God and ask for His help, He will prepare for us.
- We must always first ask God because His promise will open doors for us (Isaiah 22:22).

Jonah 2:6-7

- How did God save Jonah?
 - Jonah cried out to God while he was inside of the fish.
 - Jonah cried out to God's name, and with his whole heart, he turned back towards God's temple.
 - Jonah was saved through his heart of repentance.
- Lifting up our hands to worship and praise is very important.

Matthew 9:12 | John 18:10 | Mark 5:25-34

- "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick."
- Jesus is the ultimate healer, and we can see this through both healing the servant who had just lost his ear (John 18:10) and the bleeding woman (Mark 5).

Isaiah 22:22

- The ways that Jesus opens with us, nobody can close.

- When we have Jesus' commission, we must run with all our might.
 - If we run into obstacles, we just need to lift up our hands and worship continually for Jesus will put the key on our shoulder.
 - This is why we must learn to worship in spirit and in truth.
 - When we have God's key, we will have power and strength.
 - We will become healthy.
 - We must call out to God from deep inside.
 - We must yearn for God's help by walking and praying.
 - With this we will have strength to carry out God's plan for us.
- We must learn to have a teachable spirit.
 - If we truly love Jesus and worship, He will use His key and open the door for us.
 - When He opens the door, His mercy and miracles will come upon us.
 - This is God's grace.
- When we love Jesus and truly worship, God's mercy, miracles, healing, and blessings will all come to us.
 - God truly wants to help us and loves to help us.

John 10:2-3 | Isaiah 40:28-29 | Revelations 3:7-8 | Psalms 8:2 | John 4:4-26

- When we run into trouble, we only need God to open the door for us, and all our problems will be solved.
- No matter what we are going through in life, the voice of God will come.
 - This is the command of God, and He will open doors for us.
 - It is not by man's will, but by God's command that doors are opened and closed.
 - Our only privilege is to pray.
- We do not need to be afraid because our God is the everlasting God that has created everything for us.
 - We do not need to complain or envy.
- The key that God wants to give us is obtainable at church through worshiping in spirit and in truth.
 - This is why we must learn to worship and praise rather than complain or envy.
 - Our tongue of worship will enter God's temple and all of our problems will be solved.
 - This is why in Psalms 8 it says that through the lips of infant and children ordained praise.
 - Speaking in tongues is very important.
 - Through this we can gain strength and all our enemies will flee.
 - We will gain the power to overcome all of our circumstances and enter into God's holiness and truth.
 - Therefore, we must wholeheartedly worship in spirit and in truth.
 - This is why speaking in tongues is so miraculous for there is no limitations.
 - Our language will be changed into that of God which will reach heaven and solve our problems.
- What is the gate for the sheep?
 - It is the gate to our success, but we must first learn to worship in holiness and truth.
 - When we truly repent and return and worship in spirit and in truth, Jesus will tell us all things.
 - The first obstacle we must overcome is to learn to worship.
 - We must not let anything hold us back, but we must lift up our hands and call out to God.
