- We do not come to church merely as a religious meeting.
- Power is from:
 - Jesus' blood
 - Jesus' new and living way for us
 - Jesus' body
- Without blood, there is no forgiveness.
 - Only the blood of Jesus can bring forgiveness.
- It is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.
 - Their blood only reminds us of the sins we have committed.

- It is only by Jesus' blood that we may have forgiveness because it has no imperfections.
 - Jesus' blood was sacrificed once for all unlike that of livestock which is sacrificed annually.
- Jesus is our redemption, and only by His precious blood may we achieve salvation.
- Jesus has helped us to redeem our relationship with God.
- Because of Jesus blood having cleansed us, we are all holy.
 - We can come before the Lord.
 - We are no longer of the world, but the sons of God.
 - As a family in Christ, we must forgive each other and cover each other up.
 - When we forgive others, God will also forgive us.
- Once God has forgiven us, He will also answer our prayers.
- God will not leave us nor forsake us.
 - God will never do away with us but will love us forever.
- We must turn our hearts to God.

- As we take Jesus' blood and flesh we will receive eternal life.
 - o The blood and flesh of Jesus has life, and through that life, we will be healed.
- We must come before God every day and give thanks to Him.
- We must be baptized and receive the Holy Spirit, for when the Holy Spirit sees that we have truly repented and returned, we will receive Jesus' blood.
 - The Holy Spirit will counsel us and teach us what we need to do.
 - When we have received the blood of Jesus, the destroyer will pass over us just like in Exodus.

•	When the blood of Jesus has covered us, we will be safe and have success. In God, nothing is impossible. We must remember that coming to church, reading the Bible and acting upon it, and lifting up our hands and praying is the way to receive Jesus' blood and creation for us.
