Main Bible Verse:

(Psalms 92:10-11) But my horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil. Mine eye also shall see my desire on mine enemies, and mine ears shall hear my desire of the wicked that rise up against me.

Summary:

Psalms 92:10-11

- We must learn to praise until the anointing of God comes upon us.
- We must trust and praise God without end.
 - When we do this, we will have peace, power, and the strength of God.
 - We will also receive the revelation of God.
- Anointing is the strength from God.
 - The anointing will help us to achieve things that we cannot do.
- When we have the anointing of God, we will be able to understand what God wants us to do.
- The horn of anointing oil is very powerful, and without oil, we will not have power.

John 4:23-24

- We must use the anointing from God to glorify His name.
- With anointing we will have the power of the Holy Spirit.
 - We will be able to pray for people because we will pray and study God's word.
 - We must help people to come closer to God and allow them to also receive God's anointing.
- With anointing, we will be a person of worship and praise.
 - It will be easier for us to spread the Gospel because the Holy Spirit is there to help us.
- Without anointing, church is just a place of meeting, but with anointing, the church will be a vessel of God.
- Nothing matters if we do not have the anointing and power from God.
- By the power of the Holy Spirit, the church will have power.
 - It is not by anything we do, but by the anointing and power of God.
- When we praise God, we must worship in spirit and in truth.
- With the anointing of God, He will give us wisdom and methods to do what we need to do.
- Regardless of what we do, we need God's anointing.

1 John 2:27 | 1 Samuel 16:1

- We must not only receive anointing at church, but we must also praise and worship everywhere else so we can keep that anointing.
 - With anointing, the Holy Spirit will teach us all things.
 - We must not let our anointing run empty.
- We must be careful to not lose our anointing.
 - We must continually worship God to avoid losing our anointing.
- We must get up and return to worship.
 - When we do, we will receive a new direction from God.
- We must forget everything that may hinder us from worshipping, and God will prepare for us.
- We must fill ourselves back up with oil when we run dry.

Matthew 24:21-22 | Luke 4:18-19 | Isaiah 61:1-7

- This end time is not a time for sorrow, but we must help those around us to also receive the anointing of God.
 - This is a perfect time to spread the gospel, but we must keep our anointing and refill our horn with oil every day.
- When we have the anointing of God, we can spread the gospel, and those we share it with will receive joy.
 - Those who are troubled will be set free.
- We must keep our anointing so that we will know what to do and when to do it.
 - The Holy Spirit will also warn us of any dangers.
- We must trust in the anointing of the Holy Spirit
- We must also set a covenant with God.
 - We must set a time to praise God in spirit and in truth and read His word.
- With the anointing of God, we will be able to overcome temptations.
