Summary:

- The beloved in the book of Song of Songs is our Lord Jesus Christ. This is how God was described in the Old Testament.
- In the Book of Revelation in the New Testament, it talked about the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. And we are to rejoice and be glad and give him glory!
- In the book of Song of Songs, the bride was all about herself at the beginning. But as her understand the love of God, she starts to love God, to glorify God, to offer all she has stored for God, and to live her life completely for God.
 - This bride's life is us when we first come to believe in Christ. We were first drawn by God's love, then we began to understand God's love, and eventually our lives were transformed and were able to live a life as instruments sharing God's love.
