

We Must Not Become Famished

Main Bible Verse:

(Genesis 25:29-34) Once when Jacob was cooking some stew, Esau came in from the open country, famished. He said to Jacob, "Quick, let me have some of that red stew! I'm famished!" (That is why he was also called Edom.) Jacob replied, "First sell me your birthright." "Look, I am about to die," Esau said. "What good is the birthright to me?" But Jacob said, "Swear to me first." So he swore an oath to him, selling his birthright to Jacob. Then Jacob gave Esau some bread and some lentil stew. He ate and drank, and then got up and left. So Esau despised his birthright.

Summary:

Genesis 25:19-34 | Matthew 16:26

- Nobody can gain the entire world, but our life surpasses the entire world.
- Nothing in this world is worth getting famished for.
- Our own feelings and judgement may not be correct, but God's commission for us is always right.
 - We must obtain our commission from God and do everything accordingly.
- Esau truly became famished, and due to this, he lost his birthright.
 - Jacob took advantage of Esau's famished state and took his birthright.
- When we are tired or weary, we must call out to God and ask for His strength.
- We must be trained and molded by God, for that is how we achieve success.
- We must not take feeling as our faith.

1 Corinthians 13:4-8

- Love is patient, but we must have more than just patience.
 - We must also bring about kindness through our patience.
- Through our faith and following of God's commission for us, we must have God's love.
- From suffering we must develop perseverance.
 - Through this perseverance, we must also develop kindness. When we face suffering, if we ask God, he will give us anointing and power, to help us.
- We must not be afraid of perseverance.
- We must not be afraid of the suffering and attacks that we may face while developing perseverance.

John 14:6 | John 4

- We must not do anything without God's direction because He is our way.
- We must only rely on Jesus.
 - He will take our suffering, hardship, and pain.
- Although the world is full of corruption, but we must keep ourselves Holy.
 - Our body is the source of our life, so we must keep ourselves pure.
- As we continue to read the Bible, we must keep getting closer to Jesus and strengthening ourselves.
 - We must not let ourselves be famished but be strengthened through God.
- If we are famished, we will go through battles of failure.
- Before we get married, we must kneel down and ask God who we must marry.
 - We must follow God's way for us because He has the best for us.
- Only through patience and perseverance, will we be able to receive God's way for us.

- Church is the place that can teach us everything, so we must always attend services.

John 3:1-20 | 2 Corinthians 12:2

- What does it mean to be born again?
 - Being born again means to have our man in Christ within us grow.
 - We must be born of water and the Spirit.
 - “Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit” (John 3:6).
- Water baptism goes through water, and the baptism of the Holy Spirit is speaking in new tongues when the Holy Spirit comes down upon us.
 - These two baptisms must not be taken lightly.
 - Someone who is baptized by water has a completely different experience as those who go through the baptism of the Holy Spirit, and Jesus said that we must go through both.
 - “Very truly I tell you, we speak of what we know, and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony. I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things? (John 3:11-12).

Mark 16:17 | John 14:26 | Psalms 8:2 | 1 Corinthians 14:1-2, 18 | John 10:10

- Through the Holy Spirit, we will be able to hear God’s direction for us.
 - “But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you” (John 14:26).
- Anything and everything we do must be through the instructions and direction from God.
- Why is it important to receive the Holy Spirit?
 - “Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger” (Psalms 8:2).
 - This is speaking in tongues, and through speaking in tongues, we will receive power from God.
 - Speaking in tongues is the official language of heaven.
 - “For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God. Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit” (1 Corinthians 14:2).
 - Truly following the way of love is through speaking in tongues with the Holy Spirit. (1 Corinthians 14:1)
 - This power from speaking in tongues will bring us success.
 - Praying in tongues is the strongest form of prayer, and the enemy will flee.
 - Paul said, “I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you” (1 Corinthians 14:18).
- “The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full” (John 10:10).
 - Therefore, we must pray in tongues until we receive the power and love from God, and through this, we will receive the life that He wants to give us.
- We must call out to God and ask for the Holy Spirit to teach us what we need to know.
