Summary:

Luke 17:11-19

- God is searching for people with a thanksgiving heart.
- God is always speaking to us and telling us that He wants to bless those who are grateful.
- That is why in Luke 17, He asks where the other 9 lepers were.
- Jesus came to earth to heal us.
- When Jesus told the 10 lepers to talk to the priest, there is a very important truth.
 - When we have faith with deeds, we will be healed.
 - Jesus did not tell them that they are healed, but He gave them a test of faith and deeds.
 - The 10 lepers acted in faith because at that time, lepers were sent to live outside of the city until they got well.
 - The 10 lepers had faith as well as deeds, so they were cleansed.
- God wishes to give us miracles and healing, but we must first have faith and deeds.
- Faith without deeds will not be rewarded for our deeds prove our faith.
- If we hope to have miracles, we must have deeds.
- We must come to church, read the Bible, pray, and repent and return.
 - We must truly have a heart of repentance.
- We must truly receive and understand the phrase "your faith has made you well" (Luke 17:19).
- We must learn to be like the Samaritan who had returned after he had been healed and return to Jesus to give thanks.
- Our offerings are not about how much we give, but how much faith we have.
- When the Holy Spirit moves, we must move with it and have faith and deeds.
- As soon as we act upon our faith, we will be healed.
- Only when we have received the word from God must we act upon our faith.
 - We must have the word from God.
 - We must have the faith of thanksgiving.

- When we show love to those around us, we will surely have success and blessings.
 - Love never fails.
- When others wrong us, it is their own business, but us loving even those who have wronged us is the business between us and God.
