Summary:

2 Kings 5 | John 14:6

- The word given by God is the beginning of faith.
 - When we lift up our hands to worship and open the Bible to read, we must, with a whole heart and whole will, believe in God.
 - We must have faith that God will heal us and bless us.
 - We must also focus on God so that we do not end up empty handed.
 - Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me' (John 14:6).
- Naaman did not know how to deal with his leprosy, but he knew the word of God through an Israelite servant.
 - This servant suggested that he find the prophet Elisha.
- In all that we do, we must have both apostleship and prophetic word to work together.
 - When we come before God, we pray and ask for the word from God so that we know what we must do and how we must do it.
 - We must also listen to the prophet.
 - We must be careful that God's divine word truly comes down to us.
- How can we encounter prophet?
 - There must be two people: an apostle and a prophet.
 - When we pray together, we will receive a word from God, and our success depends on it.
 - When we receive the word, we must have faith and do accordingly.

Acts 16:25-28 | Matthew 11:28

- Our prayer must be with at least two people.
 - Paul and Silas knew to pray and worship even during midnight while they were locked up.
 - They knew that prayer and worship would bring down the power from heaven.
- If we have yet to achieve success, we should find another to pray with us such that the power comes down from heaven, and we will be successful.

- All those in jail with Paul and Silas were listening to their prayer and worship.
 - When we worship in spirit and in truth, God will surely help us and give us success.
- Miracles when Paul and Silas were in prison:
 - A violent earthquake came and shook the foundation of the prison.
 - The chains fell off.
 - The prison doors flew open.
 - The jailer did not hurt himself.
- When we encounter frustrations or trouble, we must have even greater faith.
 - We must come to church to pray until God tells us what we must do.
 - We must not doubt but pray with great faith and patience until we receive the word from God.
- When we receive success, we must still continue to come to church to pray and worship.
 - We must not stop coming to church to receive the word from God.
 - We will have even more success if we inquire of God with humility.
- We must continue to press forward without giving up even if we encounter obstacles.
 - We can give our burdens to God, and He will give us peace.
 - “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest” (Matthew 11:28).
- Before we do anything, we must inquire of God.
- We do not need to be afraid; we only need to believe.

Matthew 16:26

- Our most important business is spreading the gospel and bringing people to church.
- We must bring others to church to believe as well for every person we bring to God is worth more than the entire world.
- “What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?” (Matthew 16:26).
