Summary:

Proverbs 12:18 | Genesis 1:1-5 | Genesis 2:19

- v(Proverbs 12:18) Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.
 - With the wisdom of God, our words bring healing.
 - Without the wisdom of God, our words could be poisonous and brought destruction.
- God's Word created heaven and earth.
 - v(John 1:1-4) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.
- God created man in his own image. God gave Adam the authority, and whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name.

Matthew 12:36-37 | Proverbs 18:21 | II Kings 5:13

- v(Matthew 12:36-37) But I tell you that men will have to give account on the day of judgment for every careless word they have spoken. For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned."
 - Every word through our lips is accounted for.
 - Do we speak the word of God? Or do we speak the word of slandering?
 - v(Proverbs 18:21) The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
 - The words of Naaman's wife's servant helped him to follow prophet Elisha's instruction and his leprosy was healed.
 - Let our lips speak the word of God and be the blessing to those around us.

Proverbs 25:11 | Ecclesiastes 5:2 | Colossians 3:21 | Ephesians 4:29 | Ecclesiastes 3:7 | Esther 4:16 | Matthew 5:37 |

John 8:44

- A word aptly spoken = Do not be quick with your mouth.
 - v(Ecclesiastes 5:2) Do not be quick with your mouth, do not be hasty in your heart to utter anything before God. God is in heaven and you are on earth, so let your words be few.
- Parents are to speak the word of God to build our children up.

- v(Colossians 3:21) Fathers, do not embitter your children, or they will become discouraged.
- A word aptly spoken = Benefit those who listen.
 - v(Ephesians 4:29) Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
- A word aptly spoken = There are time to be silent and time to speak.
 - v(Ecclesiastes 3:7) a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak,
 - When we pray in tongue, the Holy Spirit will help us and guide us to say what we have to say, at when we should say them.
 - Esther fasted and prayed. She received the wisdom of God to say the right thing to king Xerxes at the right time, and the Jews were spared.
- A word aptly spoken = Let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'.
 - v(Matthew 5:37) Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one.
 - Do not exaggerate. Say nothing more than the truth.
 - v(John 8:44) You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desire. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.
 - Do not lie.

I Corinthians 14:6 | Matthew 12:34-36 | John 7:37-39 | Acts 2:3-4 | I Corinthians 14:1-3

- Be filled with the Holy Spirit and pray in tongue, so we may receive the word of revelation, knowledge, prophecy, and word of instruction from God.
- Lift up our hands and pray daily.
 - v(John 7:38) Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him."
 - v(Matthew 3:11) "I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.
 - v(Acts 2:3-4) They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
 - Let the Holy Spirit fill us and let the living water flow from within us.
 - Pray in tongue and let the tongue of fire cleanse us.
- When we are filled with the Holy Spirit and speaking in tongue, we are uttering mysteries with our spirit.
 - v(I Corinthians 14:1-3) Follow the way of love and eagerly desire spiritual gifts, especially the gift of prophecy. For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God. Indeed, no one understands him; he utters mysteries with his spirit. But everyone who prophesies speaks to men for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort.
