Summary:

Psalm 71:14-17 | John 10:10 | John 14:6

- Our real hope is in God and His kingdom.
- We mustn't let ourselves be distracted and destroyed by the devil's scheme.
- We must learn to come before God and cry out to God.
 - We must pray until we are filled with the Holy Spirit.
- Satan will attack us with the environment and situations, but we must not lose hope.
 - Rather, we must come before God and praise Him even more.
 - We must declare His righteousness.
- We must make sure that our mouths speak only praises.
 - We must keep our mouths free of complaints.
- We must rise and learn from David.
 - We must obediently follow God and praise more and more regardless of our circumstance.
- The more we praise and worship, the bigger our miracles and blessings will be.
 - In all we do, we must let our mouths utter words of praise.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 | Hebrews 10:25 | Matthew 28:19-20 | John 1:1-5

- Apart from our praise, we must establish our altar.
 - We must set a time to read the Bible daily.
 - “All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work” (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
 - When we read the Bible, we must ask God to use His spirit to guide us.
 - We must also set a time to pray daily in tongues.
 - Believing in God is not merely a religion, but it is establishing a relationship with Him.
 - We must establish our communication with God through our prayers.

- We must confess our sins and repent and return.
 - We must truly have a heart of repentance.

 - Coming to church is coming to meet God, and we will receive healing, anointing, and revelations from God.
- We must also spread the gospel.
 - “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age” (Matthew 28:19-20).
- We must learn to walk with God.
 - “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God” (John 1:1).
 - We must walk with God until we are one with Him in everything we do.

1 Corinthians 12:7-9 | 1 Samuel 16:11 | 1 Samuel 17 | Matthew 6:33

- “Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit,” (1 Corinthians 12:7-9).
 - The wisdom from the Spirit is the direction that we God gives us.
 - The message of knowledge from the Spirit is the method for us by which we must follow the direction.
 - The faith from the Spirit is the action we must take to act upon the method that God has given us by the Spirit.
 - The healing is God setting us free from the bondage of our circumstance.
- We come before God not to gain riches or fame, but we come before God to receive Jesus, understand salvation, become a new creation through baptism, and to become the temple of God.
 - When we come before God, we will surely be healthy.
- We must not follow our own feelings for it is not always right, but God has already prepared the best path for us.
 - All that we do by ourselves is in vain, but with God, we will achieve success.
- We must learn to worship in spirit and in truth and allow the Holy Spirit to work in our lives.
 - We will be able to receive the message of wisdom, the message of knowledge, faith, and the gift of healing.
 - We must depart from our own thoughts and methods.
- David received the anointing from God, so he had the authority to challenge Goliath.
 - When we have the presence of the Lord with us, we will encounter many miracles in our lives.
 - We will have wisdom, power, revelation, success, and protection when we rely on the anointing from God.
 - All that we do will be successful and prosper.
- If we want to receive the anointing from God, we must have the kingdom of God in our heart.
 - We must care for God’s household, people, and work.

- “But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you” (Matthew 6:33).
- Once we have received, we must give glory to God and deny ourselves to do the work of God.
- Once we have received the anointing from God, satan will attempt to attack us, but we must stand firm in our faith.
 - We must lift up our hands and bless any who may try to discourage us.
- If we want to do the great deeds of God, we must deny ourselves and let go of our own power and feelings to allow the Holy Spirit to guide us.
 - We must throw away of the “no” of our past life and enter into God’s work.
- We must only do things that God wants us to do.
 - We must first receive our message of wisdom before we do anything.
- We must learn to be full of faith and have hope in God.
 - Regardless of our circumstance, we must praise and pray until the Holy Spirit comes to us.
 - We must pray until we receive the wisdom, knowledge, faith, and healing from the Holy Spirit.
