

The Meaning Of Easter

Main Bible Verse:

(Luke 24:1-8) On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'" Then they remembered his words.

Luke 24:1-8

- The Resurrection of Jesus is the foundation for our belief.
- We need to take Easter very seriously.
- Jesus died on the cross and suffered great pain for us.
- Jesus' resurrection is an assurance of our resurrection.
- Without the resurrection of Jesus, there would not be forgiveness of sins.
- We need to glorify and praise the Lord's name with a grateful heart.
- The greatest news that Angels have given the world is that Jesus is not here, but he has risen.
- Jesus' resurrection does not only apply to Easter.
 - It applies to our daily life and allows for our sins to be forgiven.
- Jesus rising from the dead gives us a promise of everlasting life.
- The resurrection of Jesus allows us to establish a relationship with God.
- We can live through the strength of the Holy Spirit because Jesus died on the cross for us.
- Every day of our life should be like Resurrection Day.
- There are 4 points of the resurrection.
 - Our sins are forgiven.
 - We have a gift of everlasting life.
 - Immanuel God With Us.
 - We will have the power of resurrection every day.

Isaiah 53:4-6 | Hebrews 9:11-14

- Jesus took all our pain, grief, and all our negative emotions and put it on himself.
- Jesus was a perfect man, but he was pierced for our transgressions and crushed for our inequities.

- Jesus felt extreme pain so that we could be forgiven.
- On the cross, Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.” (Luke 23:34)
- On his last breath, Jesus said “It is Finished.”
- Jesus appeared before God as a lamb slain for the sins of the world.
 - It was accepted by God as the ultimate sacrifice for our sins.
- Jesus’ resurrection serves as an approval for his death as an atonement for our sins.
 - Our sins are now forgiven when we confess our sins.
 - Jesus’ resurrection allows us to call God our father and establish a relationship with him.
 - This is evident because of all the things God has done in our lives.
 - This is how we receive healings and miracles.
 - We can feel the presence of the Holy Spirit when we pray.
- Everything we get comes from the Lord because Jesus died on the cross for us.
- Every day, we must give thanks to God.
- Jesus died on the cross because he loved us.

John 11:25 | John 3:16 | 1 Corinthians 15:42-44 | 1 Corinthians 15: 52-58

- Jesus told us that death is not the end for us. We must look forward to living in the Kingdom with God in heaven.
- As Christians, we must believe that we will be resurrected just like Jesus.
- When life passes on, our bodies will decay, but our spirit and soul will live on.
- When we receive Jesus as our lord and savior, we will have eternal life.
- For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)
- When we die, though we are absent in the body, we will live forever with Christ.
 - We will not have pain or sickness.
- Spreading the gospel is very important.
 - This could be reminding other Christians to come to church.
- Everyone has their problems, but Jesus loves us, and he will help us live joyfully every day.
- We need to tell other people about Jesus so they can receive the everlasting life that we have.
- After we are resurrected, we will have a glorious body in heaven.
 - We will not have any flaws.
- Jesus will come and rapture or resurrect us.

John 14:16-18

- Jesus will not leave us as orphans. God will always be with you when you pray and call out.
- Joshua was a man who was full of spirit and God helped him win every battle.
- When Daniel was thrown in the lion’s den, God was with him and helped him.
- Paul and Silas were in prison and miracles happened.
- When we are in Church, we must worship the Lord with all our heart, soul, and mind and allow the resurrection spirit to come upon us.
- When we are at home worshipping and reading the bible, God is speaking to us.
- We must worship in all circumstances.’

- Immanuel, God with us is the Holy Spirit being on us.
- Having God in us is bigger than anything of the world.
- The Holy Spirit will guide you and give you directions to help you achieve success.
- Our lives are very different from those who don't believe because God is with us.
- We should take time to pray and worship.

Romans 8:11

 - This is the same Holy Spirit that lives in us.
- The Holy Spirit will give life to our bodies.
- Our bodies are subject to weakness. However, when we cry out to the Lord, the Holy Spirit will give us life.
 - This life is a life of anointing, power, and strength.
- Nothing can separate us from the love of Jesus.
- Nothing can hold us down because the Holy Spirit allows us to be resurrected.
- Because of Good Friday, we can look back on not be afraid because our sins are forgiven.
- Because of Easter, we can look forward and not be afraid because we know that Jesus will always be with us.
- Because of the Pentecost, we have the Holy Spirit and not be afraid.
