Summary:

Hebrews 10:1-2 | Hebrews 10:17-18 | Psalms 103:11-12

- When we believe that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and repent and return in Jesus Name, our sins are forgiven.
 - Only Jesus' blood could wash away our sins.
 - We must repent and return.
- God loves us and does not want us to be bound or captivated by sins. Therefore, He sent His Spirit to set us free.

Hebrews 10:19-20 | Hebrews 10:22-23

- We have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
- Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body.
- Through Jesus' blood, we may come before God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, that Jesus has cleansed us from a guilty conscience.

Hebrews 10:25-26 | Ecclesiastes 5:1 | Ecclesiastes 5:2-5

- Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another--and all the more as you see the Day approaching. If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left.
 - We must not stop going to church services.
 - Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. Go near to listen rather than to offer the sacrifice of fools, who do not know that they do wrong.
 - Being physically present is not enough. We must come to church with a reverent heart eagerly desire to be filled with the Holy Spirit and receive God's word.
 - We come to church to meet God, and to worship Him in spirit and in truth until we receive His instructions.
 - Therefore, Jesus said, He is the way, the truth, and the live.
- Do not be quick with your mouth, do not be hasty in your heart to utter anything before God. God is in heaven and you are on earth, so let your words be few.
- When you make a vow to God, do not delay in fulfilling it. He has no pleasure in fools; fulfill your vow.

- God wants to help us, He is waiting for us to come before Him in spirit and in truth.

Hebrews 11:6 | Matthew 8:8

- And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
- The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed."
 - Come before God with full faith, knowing the word of God could solve all our problems.

Luke 18:29-30 | Romans 8:18 | Hebrews 10:24

- Truly I tell you," Jesus said to them, "no one who has left home or wife or brothers or sisters or parents or children for the sake of the kingdom of God will fail to receive many times as much in this age, and in the age to come eternal life."
- I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.
 - Come before God with Hope.
 - Pray that the eyes of our heart may be enlightened in order that we may know the hope to which God has called us, the riches of His glorious inheritance in His holy people.

Matthew 6:12 | John 15:12

- And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds,
 - The Lord's prayer taught us, forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
 - Jesus gave us the following command: Love each other as I have loved you.
 - Love one another, forgive one another, and pray for one another.

II Corinthians 5:17-20 | Ephesians 2:8-10 | Acts 4:12

- Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.
- For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-- not by works, so that no one can boast.
- Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."
 - It is by the grace of God we are saved, through faith.
 - Not by ourselves, nor our actions.
 - Only under Jesus' name, we may be saved.
 - We must be filled with the Holy Spirit and share the good news.
- So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. For, "In just a little while, he who is coming will come and will not delay." And, "But my righteous one will live by faith. And I take no pleasure in the one who shrinks back." But we do not belong to those who shrink back and are destroyed, but to those who have faith and are saved.
