Summary:

Romans 7:15-25 | I Corinthians 9:26-27 | John 14:6

- The same attitude that Jesus suffered in His body, is what helps us overcome our evil human desires.
- v(Romans 7:21-25) So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me. For in my inner being I delight in God's law; but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me. What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!
 - Only through Jesus, we may overcome.
 - Jesus Christ is the word became flesh to show us the way to overcome.
 - Though by ourselves, we might feel like giving in to our own fleshly desires, but through Jesus Christ our Lord, we are empowered to overcome.
 - When we fear the Lord and follow the word of God, we will receive the strength to overcome the sinful nature of man.
- v(I Corinthians 9:26-27) Therefore I do not run like a man running aimlessly; I do not fight like a man beating the air. No, I beat my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.
 - Jesus is our way, our truth, and our life.
 - When we let Jesus be our way, we will not run aimlessly, and we will receive the strength to beat our body and make it our slave (overcome our fleshly desire).

I Peter 1:6-7 | I Peter 2:20-21 | I Peter 3:14 | Matthew 5:10 | I Peter 3:17

- Though hardships are inevitable in life, the following bible verses could help us:
 - See how hardships could be beneficial to us.
 - Learn how to overcome hardships.

- v(I Peter 1:6-7) In all this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.
- v(I Peter 2:20-21) But how is it to your credit if you receive a beating for doing wrong and endure it? But if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God. To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps.
- v(I Peter 3:14) But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed. “Do not fear their threats[a]; do not be frightened.”
- v(Matthew 5:10) Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- v(I Peter 3:17) For it is better, if it is God’s will, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil.

I Peter 4:1-2 | James 1:13-15 | Matthew 16:24 |

- v(James 1:13-15) When tempted, no one should say, “God is tempting me.” For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.
 - God does not tempt anyone.
 - Each person is tempted by their own evil desire.
 - After desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin.
- But Jesus already taught us how to overcome, the way to separate us from sin.
 - v(Matthew 16:24) Then Jesus said to his disciples, “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.
 - Do not give in to our fleshly desires, but to deny ourselves, take up the cross, and follow Jesus.
 - Example of denying ourselves:
 - Joseph never gave in to sin, for he feared the Lord.
 - Joseph never complains, for he understood the plan of God is to save many.
 - God exalted Joseph.
 - Example of NOT denying ourselves:
 - On the other hand, David gave in to his own fleshly desire and took Uriah’s wife.
 - God sent Prophet Nathan to tell David, “the sword will never depart from your house”.

Hebrews 5:8-10 | Luke 22:42 | Galatians 5:16-17

- Jesus overcame by humbling himself before God and obeying the word of God.
 - v(Philippians 2:5-8) Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross!
 - v(Luke 22:42) “Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.”
- Live by the Spirit, and we will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature.
 - v(Galatians 5:16-17) So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want.

1 Peter 4:3 | Ephesians 2:1-3 | Hebrews 11:24-25 |

- It is by grace we have been saved.
- Depart from our old self, for the grace, love, and mercy of God, made us alive in Christ even when we were dead in transgressions.
 - v(Ephesians 2:1-5) As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our flesh and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature deserving of wrath. But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.
- Rejoice in hardships and let the glory of God be revealed.
 - (1 Peter 4:12-16) Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. But rejoice inasmuch as you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed. If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. If you suffer, it should not be as a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler. However, if you suffer as a Christian, do not be ashamed, but praise God that you bear that name.
