Philippians 3:10-14 | Acts 9 | Acts 1:8 | Luke 17:30-35 | Genesis 19:15-17 | Genesis 19:23-26

- When we act upon the word, it is a thanksgiving act to God.
- We must receive Christ and to know Christ.
 - o The most important thing in our lives is to have Jesus Christ in our hearts.
 - When we have Jesus in our hearts, we have the whole world.
- What does it mean by it when Paul states, "I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it"?
 - Apostle Paul says that he wants to further know Christ and the power of his resurrection.
 - Paul tells the churches that he is not perfect and that he wants to get to know Christ better and have the direction from God.
- To understand Christ more, we must forget what is behind and strain toward what is ahead.
 - We cannot allow our mistakes and regrets to bind our hearts because if our hearts are bound, we cannot move forward.
- On the way to Damascus, Paul received Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior and believed that Jesus is Lord,
 repented of his sins, and was filled with the Holy Spirit.
 - o Paul needed to forget his past in order to move forward for the kingdom of God.
- What does it mean to forget what is behind?

- We must not allow our past to influence our present.
- We must be willing to confess, repent and follow Jesus Christ.
 - We must believe that Jesus has already forgiven our sins and trust in His word.
 - By the blood of Jesus, we are able to overcome our past.
 - By the Holy Spirit, we are able to overcome.
- We will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon us.
 - o It is not by our own power that we do anything, but the blood of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Because of the love of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit, we will be able to forget what is behind and strain for the kingdom of God.
- We must learn to forgive and let go in order for us to move forward for the kingdom.
 - We must not hold grudges and keep records of the wrong of others.
- We must also repent and ask God for forgiveness of the things that we did wrong.
 - We must continually come to church and pray in the Holy Spirit to let all the condemnation out of our hearts.
- Lot's wife looked back and became the pillar of salt. She did not merely look back to see what happened to Sodom and Gomorrah, but she looked back with he heart longing for her past.
 - o If we have anything that we do not want to let go of, we will become stuck and unable to move.
- We must let go, forgive, and forget.
 - Only then will we be able to receive God's new and living way for us.
- We need to not only pray, but also study the word of God and let it guide us and lead us.
- We must remember that we have Jesus Christ and the word of God.
 - As long as we are willing to repent and change, we will be forgiven.

Philippians 3:10-14 | Acts 2:46-47 | Psalms 8:2

- Straining for the Lord means that we fix our eyes on Jesus.
- Jesus is the author and perfector of our faith and the anchor of our soul.
 - We must develop our relationship with the Lord daily.
 - We must read the bible, praise the Lord, and pray in the Holy Spirit.
- We cannot say we love God and not read the word of God.
 - o You cannot separate Jesus from the Bible.
 - o The Bible is the word from God.
 - o The more we read the bible, we will better know the promises and the laws of God.
 - We must read the bible until it becomes life to us.
 - When we continually read the word of God, God will use His word to guide us and lead us.
- When we have Jesus as our best friend, He will tell us all things to come and will guide us and lead us.
- To strain for Christ is to read the bible and pray in the Holy Spirit daily.
 - Only when we are filled with the power of the Holy Spirit, are we able to forget what is behind.
- When we speak in tongues, God will establish a power on us that will allow us to overcome, our hatred, anger, and unforgiveness.
 - When we pray until our tongues become ordained praise, the Holy Spirit will remove all the chaff and condemnation in us and assist us in straining for the Kingdom of God.

•	Rather than looking back at our mistakes and having regret, we must repent and ask God to help us change.
•	What is the prize that we are seeking?
	 The prize that Paul is speaking of in verse 10 is being able to know Jesus more.
	 When we pray and inquire of the Lord, we will know how to act.
	 Another prize is the great hope of being raptured and reign with Christ for 1000 years.
•	Our hearts must be hollow. We must not hold any grudges or hate but focus only on straining for the kingdom.
	 When we strive for the kingdom of God, we will receive miracles in our lives.
