Summary:

Matthew 6:31-34 | 2 Corinthians 1:20-22

- No matter what happens in our life, we know that Jesus shed His blood for us so that we may receive His blessings and healing.
- As long as we have the kingdom in our heart, we will be joyful.
 - We will have the Holy Spirit in our heart for the kingdom is where the Spirit dwells.
- When we run into problems, we must lift our hands to heaven and call out to God.
 - We mustn't fall into the scheme of the devil for Jesus can turn our life around.
 - All we need to do is seek God's kingdom and righteousness.
- What God prepares for us is beyond what we can imagine.
- When we seek God's kingdom and righteousness, we will receive authority from God.
 - (Matthew 6:33) But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
 - Not only will our prayers be answered, but our prayers will also be able to affect our future as well.
- God will turn our lives around just like how He turned Ruth's life around.
 - Although Ruth lost everything, she sought God's kingdom and righteousness, and God greatly blessed her.

- We need not expect anything from man, but we should place our expectations in heaven.
 - God knows what we need and has already prepared it for us.
- Jesus left the kingdom for us here on earth.
 - The church has the keys of the kingdom of heaven as well as the revelation of the Father.
 - Regardless of what we need or what problem we have, Jesus has already prepared it for us.
- We must believe in the word of God for there is no word that is empty.
 - (2 Corinthians 1:20) For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.
- We must not allow our pride to overcome us.
 - It was by his pride that satan was struck down from heaven.
 - We must rather have faith in Jesus' promises.
- God has His perfect will for us, and we must have complete faith in Him.
 - We must not allow the insecurity of man to affect us.
- We must not allow ourselves to be tempted by our own thoughts and feelings.
 - We must wake up early to pray and come to church.
 - We need the anointing from God to stand firm.
 - We need to lift up our hands and ask God to help us so that we can see and hear.
- Only through righteousness was Noah able to consecrate himself and avoid the corruption of the world.
 - God chose him and gave him the instructions to make an ark.
 - We need not be afraid for God will always provide for us, lead us, and guide us.
- When we have the word of God in our heart, we will not fail.
 - Before we do anything, we must lift up our hands to pray and worship.
 - We must seek God's anointing and ask for His in everything that we do.
- We must fix our eyes on the glory of God instead of the things of the world.

Psalm 103:1-6, 19-22 | Jeremiah 29:11 | 2 Corinthians 1

- (Psalm 103:19) The Lord has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all.
- We can call out to God and ask Him to give us His peace.
 - When we ask this of God, He will calm our heart no matter how disastrous our situation may seem.
- We must focus on God and not our problems.
 - (Jeremiah 29:11) For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.
 - God knows what is best for us, and He will guide us along His path for us.
- We must be willing to be edified by God.
 - Regardless of our situation, God will help us.
 - We need to come to church to praise and serve God.
 - (Psalm 103:20-22) 20 Praise the Lord, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word. 21 Praise the Lord, all his heavenly hosts, you his servants who do his will. 22 Praise the Lord, all his works everywhere in his dominion. Praise the Lord, O my soul.
- Nobody can change God's promise for us.
 - We are chosen by God, and nothing can take what God has given to us.

- We need to rise up and have the word and anointing of God.
- We must not let our doubts cause us to worry.
 - We must cast out our doubts and call out to God to give us strength and faith.
 - God can change everything for us.
 - We must believe in the authority of the kingdom, humbly praise God, and establish a throne so that God's will and promise may come to us.
- We must only allow our heart to give thanks and praise to God.
 - We must bolster our faith for the kingdom of God is on its way.
 - We must love the church and be faithful for the church.
- God will give us the keys of the kingdom of heaven.
- Through his praise, David brought out the miracles of the cross.
 - We must come before God to thoroughly repent and return for our sins hinders our prayers.
 - We must also forgive those around us.
 - However much we forgive and bless others is however much God will forgive and bless us.
- Jesus will heal us and redeem us from death.
 - We must not fear anything including death.
 - It is not death but the fear in our heart that is concerning.
- We must pray before we do anything, even buying groceries.
- God crowns us with love and compassion, so we must not speak rashly.
 - We must not criticize and judge.
 - We must change our criticism and judgement into the blessings of God.
- God has already taken away our worries.
 - His anointing and power are already upon us.

Isaiah 55:10-12 | Psalm 33:9 | Psalm 8:2

- If we want to receive the mystery of the kingdom, we must change.
- (Psalm 33:9) For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm.
 - We must hold fast to the commands of God.
 - We must pray until we receive God's commands before doing anything.
 - Without prayer and praise, we will not have the kingdom in our heart.
 - This way we will not have the promise and authority of God with us.
 - God wants to give the message to those who are humble and deny themselves.
 - We must completely humble ourselves before God.
 - When we are poor in spirit, God will put the thoughts of the Spirit in our heart.
- Only when we have the authority of the kingdom with us will what we do go smoothly.
 - We must pray and walk in the ways of God.
- When we are willing to honor God, he will honor us.
- It is integral that we are filled with the Holy Spirit and pray in tongues.
 - When we pray in tongues, those who come to attack us will be dispersed.
 - We must empty ourselves of all our thoughts and feelings and be filled with the Spirit.

- (Psalm 8:2) From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.
- When we do not have peace, we must lift up our hands and call out to God.
 - Our thoughts of worries and hopelessness will be changed into thoughts of joy and peace.
- (Isaiah 55:10-12) 10 As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, 11 so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. 12 You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.
