Summary:

Colossians 3:12-17

- v(Colossians 3:12-17) 12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. 13 Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. 14 And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity. 15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. 16 Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. 17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
 - A new creation born in Christ must clothed themselves with the following:
 - Clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. (v12)
 - Put on love. (v14)
 - Be thankful. (v15)
 - Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly. (v16)
 - To clothe ourselves with the above to live a life that glorifies God is a commission for all God's people.

1 Corinthians 13:4 | Luke 23:34

- v(Micah 6:8) He has showed you, O man, what is good. And what does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.
 - Act Justly.
 - This is what God requires of us.
 - We, ourselves, must act justly.
 - Not a requirement for others. Do not judge.
 - Love Mercy.
 - v(James 2:13) because judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful. Mercy triumphs over judgment!
 - This is how our attitude should be toward others.
 - We must always be merciful to others.
 - Mercy triumphs over judgment.
- V(Matthew 23:1-3) 1 Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples: 2 “The teachers of the law and the Pharisees sit in Moses’ seat. 3 So you must be careful to do everything they tell you. But do not do what they do, for they do not practice what they preach.
 - Endeavor to act upon God’s word ourselves.
 - Not to require it from others.
- v(Philippians 2:3) Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves.
 - Be humble: God gives grace to the humble.
 - v(James 4:6) But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
 - v(1 Peter 5:5) Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
 - Be gentle.
- v(James 1:2-3) 1 Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, 2 because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance.
- v(Romans 5:3) Not only so, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
 - Persevere.
 - Perseverance is produced when we face trials and sufferings.
- v(1 Corinthians 13:4) Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.
- v(Luke 23:34) Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.
 - When we love others even during persecution, when we keep a joyful heart through trials and sufferings, when we keep peace by keeping our heart and our lips from judging or criticizing others, when we patiently forgive others and pray for them, God will clothe us with His kindness.

Genesis 26:19-30

- v(Colossians 3:13) Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
- v(Romans 12:18) If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
 - Live at peace with everyone.
- v(Matthew 18:35) This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you unless you forgive your brother from your heart.
 - Forgive as the Lord forgave us.
- Life of Isaac
 - v(Genesis 26:12) Isaac planted crops in that land and the same year reaped a hundredfold, because the LORD blessed him.
 - v(Genesis 26:19-30) 19 Isaac's servants dug in the valley and discovered a well of fresh water there. 20 But the herders of Gerar quarreled with those of Isaac and said, "The water is ours!" So he named the well Esek, because they disputed with him. 21 Then they dug another well, but they quarreled over that one also; so he named it Sitnah. 22 He moved on from there and dug another well, and no one quarreled over it. He named it Rehoboth, saying, "Now the Lord has given us room and we will flourish in the land." 23 From there he went up to Beersheba. 24 That night the Lord appeared to him and said, "I am the God of your father Abraham. Do not be afraid, for I am with you; I will bless you and will increase the number of your descendants for the sake of my servant Abraham." 25 Isaac built an altar there and called on the name of the Lord. There he pitched his tent, and there his servants dug a well. 26 Meanwhile, Abimelek had come to him from Gerar, with Ahuzzath his personal adviser and Phicol the commander of his forces. 27 Isaac asked them, "Why have you come to me, since you were hostile to me and sent me away?" 28 They answered, "We saw clearly that the Lord was with you; so we said, 'There ought to be a sworn agreement between us'—between us and you. Let us make a treaty with you 29 that you will do us no harm, just as we did not harm you but always treated you well and sent you away peacefully. And now you are blessed by the Lord."
 - When Isaac moved on when others started quarrelling, God appeared to him and blessed him.
- Clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Put on love. Be thankful. Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly. You will live a life that glorifies God.
