- (Luke 10:19-20) 19 I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. 20 However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”
- (Revelations 3:5) The one who is victorious will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life, but will acknowledge that name before my Father and his angels.
- Jesus is the one and only true son of God.
 - Jesus is the word become flesh that came to the world.
 - (John 10:10) The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
 - Jesus understands our troubles, so He gave us the authority to lift up our hands and pray and praise in order to overcome our problems.

- All that we face has already been faced by someone in the past, but through praise, we can overcome and experience the wonders of God.

Samuel 1:2, 4-7, 12-17

- At the time, having children, especially a son, was very important for women, and the book of Leviticus says that when a man has multiple wives, the one child who is first is to be given the blessings of the firstborn.
 - However, Elkanah loved Hannah and still gave her double portion of food instead of Peninnah even though she had no child.
 - Peninnah was jealous and continuously provoked Hannah.
- Even though Hannah was suffering, she did not complain or make accusations.
 - Hannah continued to pray and seek God patiently.
 - We also must learn to pray patiently and continue to come before God to humble ourselves and pray.
 - We must not be discouraged or lose faith, and we will see the hand of God work in our life.
 - After praying, Hannah, through Eli, received the word of God and held onto it.
 - When we receive the word from God, we must learn from Hannah and hold onto it and not let it go.
 - We must know that only through Jesus will we be able to find true satisfaction and joy.
- It is of utmost importance that we pray earnestly in tongues in the Spirit.

Hebrews 13:15 | Acts 16:16-40 | Hebrews 1:7 | Hebrews 11:6 | James 1:17 | Matthew 11:28 | Matthew 17:20

- (Hebrews 13:15) Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.
- Praise is a sacrifice that we make to God.
 - We must not make this sacrifice according to our wants but according to God’s laws and decrees.
 - We need to learn to praise God in all circumstance.
- Paul and Silas were captured, beaten, and imprisoned because of their work for the Lord.
 - Even in these circumstances, they did not complain but continued to praise God in loud voices.
 - All the prisoners around them sat and listened to them praising God.
 - In the middle of the night during their praise, God sent his angels like winds and servants like flames of fire to help them.
 - (Acts 16:26-31) 26 Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everyone’s chains came loose. 27 The jailer woke up, and when he saw the prison doors open, he drew his sword and was about to kill himself because he thought the prisoners had escaped. 28 But Paul shouted, “Don’t harm yourself! We are all here!” 29 The jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. 30 He then brought them out and asked, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?” 31 They replied, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household.”
- We do not need to be afraid or worried regardless of our circumstance because God’s glorious word will bring us great blessings.
 - God will use us in His wonderful works to save many.
- No matter how big our problem is, we must not only pray but also praise.

- This does not mean that we praise God for the suffering, but we praise Him for being with us and helping us.
 - We must proclaim that God has already solved our problems and healed us of our sickness.
- Every word from our mouth should be from God.
- (Hebrews 11:6) And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
- We must wholeheartedly believe when we praise God, and our result will be different.
 - (James 1:17) Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.
 - (Matthew 11:28) “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- Regardless of what problem or sickness we may have, God can and will help us as long as we praise Him with full faith.
 - We must not be discouraged by what others around us say or do.
 - (Matthew 17:20) He replied, “Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.”
