- When we worship at church, God will pour His oil of anointing from our head to our toes.
- We must love church.
- Baptism of water is the first miracle.
 - We must not dwell in the water baptism but strive to be baptized with the Holy Spirit and fire.
 - With our every breath, we can breathe in the Spirit and exhale all of our worries and burdens.
- God will reveal to us all things through the Holy Spirit.
 - No matter what we need to do, the Holy Spirit will guide us in the best path for us.
- Jesus told us not to leave Jerusalem, which is church.
 - Church is the place of forgiveness, so we must not harbor any unforgiveness in our hearts.
- All of our despair, complaints, and unhappiness can be resolved through thanksgiving and praise.
- We must come to meet Jesus, and we will receive His peace and be greatly blessed.
- No matter what problems we may encounter, we must have faith that Jesus is the almighty God.

- We must rid ourselves of all doubt.
- Our God is the trinity God who will answer our prayers as long as we have full faith in Him.
- God knows and rules over all things, even the number of hairs on our heads.
 - We do not need to worry about anything.
 - (Psalm 103:19) The Lord has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all.
- Lazarus died, and Jesus intentionally waited four days to test the faith of those around.
 - If God has not answered our prayers yet, He is testing our faith.
 - We must put down our feelings and have full faith in God.
- In all that we do, we must strive to follow God with full faith.
 - Our greatest hope is in resurrection through Jesus.
 - (Revelations 20:6) Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years.
- Before we do anything, we must first receive the word from God.
- Not only must we have faith, but we must also have action to accompany our faith.
 - (James 2:17) In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.
- We must be willing to lift up our hands to call out to God with faith.
 - Because of the word of God, we will receive miracles and healing.
- We must not only worship once or twice, but every day of our life.
- What does it mean that, "whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."
 - The authority of heaven is greater than that of earth.
- It is of human nature to want to complain and despair, but we can be free of these burdens because we have the authority of Jesus in our life.
 - We must work with utmost caution to not deliberately sin.
- Before we make any decisions, we must ask God, and He will send the Holy Spirit to teach us all things.
 - No matter how simple a decision seems, we must inquire of God.
- If anyone has wronged us or caused us trouble, we must forgive them.
- No matter what happens in our life, we must continue to praise and worship without worry.
 - (1 Corinthians 2:9) However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him"
