Summary:

Luke 17:17-19 | 2 Kings 5:8-11-13 | John 7:7-10

- We come to church to build up our faith.
- Jesus had special favor on the Samaritan who came back and gave thanks to the Lord.
 - Our faith is the faith that makes us well.
- Naaman was a commander who was extremely capable but ended up getting leprosy.
 - Leprosy was incurable at that time.
- Naaman came with the idea that Elisha would come out, lay his hands on him, and he would be immediately healed.
 - When Naaman washed himself seven times in the Jordan, he was truly healed.
 - This tells us that God does not want us to use our own ideas and feelings because they may not be true.
 - This is why we must pray before doing anything.
- Our success comes from us coming to church and worshipping until God’s word comes to us.
 - By our feelings, just like Naaman, we will get the wrong idea.
- When we overcome our feelings the word of God will come on us.
- (John 7:7-10) ⁷Therefore Jesus said again, “Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. ⁸All who have come before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them. ⁹I am the gate; whoever enters

through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. ¹⁰The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

- We come to church to let God open the gate for us.
- We must come to church for the right reason.
 - What is the right reason?
 - To meet the Lord.
 - We must change our mindset and not come to church for any other reason than meeting the Lord.
- We must have the word of God and believe it.
 - When we come before the Lord and pray and worship, He will help us and we will be saved.
 - We must allow the word of God to lead us and guide us in our lives.
- What does it mean to be saved?
 - We will be saved in every aspect, whether it be our health, business, or any other aspect of our lives.
- When we have a decision to make, the first thing that will come to us is our feelings.
 - What do we do then?
 - We must pray well because we know that feelings are not from God.
 - This is why we must thoroughly as God before making any decision.
 - We may not know what will happen but God knows.
- Our doubt comes from our feelings.
 - If we do not overcome this, we will not be able to enter the gate.
- We must pray until we hear the word from God because that is the word of life and the word of promise.
- If we have a problem that we do not know how to solve, we can attend morning prayer meetings.

Romans 10:13-15 | Romans 10:17

- (Romans 10:13-15) ¹³for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” ¹⁴How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”
- We must first get baptized, then have a relationship with the Lord and call out to Him every day.
 - We must not only call out to the Lord when we need something from Him or run into troubles.
- When we continuously call out to the Lord we will eventually hear from Him.
- The leper knew that Jesus could solve all of His problems.
- We do not have to shout and hurt our throats, but we must call out to the Lord and ask the Lord to change us and change our doubt into His power.
 - We must remember that all things are possible in God.
- Paul tells us that we must call out until we hear and then we can believe.
- (Romans 10:17) Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.
 - When we continually come to church and listen to the pastor’s preaching, we will hear the word from God.
- (2 Corinthians 1:19-20) ¹⁹For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us—by me and Silas and Timothy—was not “Yes” and “No,” but in him it has always been “Yes.” ²⁰For no matter how many

promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ. And so through him the “Amen” is spoken by us to the glory of God.

- We come to church to let the “Yes” of Jesus come into us.
- Elisha had the word of God and told Naaman to wash himself in the Jordan.
 - This is being sent by the anointing of the Holy Spirit and the promise of God.
- Why seven times?
 - In the bible seven means completion.
 - After Naaman washed himself seven times, he was completely healed.
- What we need is the key from the kingdom of heaven.
 - I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you lose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”
- When we rid ourselves of our feelings and are poor in spirit, we will have the kingdom of heaven in us and we will have authority.
- Romans 10 is really important because we must first pray until we hear and then get sent.
- When we fall before Jesus, we will become a new creation.

1 Corinthians 9:26-27

- (1 Corinthians 9:26-27) ²⁶Therefore I do not run like someone running aimlessly; I do not fight like a boxer beating the air. ²⁷No, I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.
- God will tell us our direction; however, we must put in the effort to read the bible and pray on a daily basis and seek the Lord.
- The Gospel of God is miraculous and is the promise and anointing of God.
 - The gospel will heal us and change us. The Gospel is the power of God.
- If we want this power, we must share the Gospel to those around us and lead them to church.
 - When we have the Gospel in us, we will see God’s miracles in our lives.
- We must follow Jesus till the end and not stop half way.
 - Elisha was blessed because he followed Elijah all the way.
 - The Leper received “Your faith has made you well” because he came back and gave thanks to Jesus.
