Main Bible Verse:

(Romans 10:9-15)⁹ If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. ¹¹ As Scripture says, “Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.” ¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, ¹³ for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” ¹⁴ How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵ And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”

Summary:

Romans 10:9-13 | Psalms 33:9 | 2 Kings 5:8-13 | John 10:7-10

- (Romans 10:9-13)⁹ If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. ¹¹ As Scripture says, “Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.” ¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, ¹³ for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”
- We must come to a church with a heart that is eager to pray and receive the word.
 - When we lift up our hands to pray, we must allow the Holy Spirit to enter us and God to speak to us.
 - One word of Jesus will solve all our problems.
- Jesus was the word in the beginning.
 - (Psalms 33:9) For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm.

- (2 Kings 5:8-11) ⁸ When Elisha the man of God heard that the king of Israel had torn his robes, he sent him this message: “Why have you torn your robes? Have the man come to me and he will know that there is a prophet in Israel.” ⁹ So Naaman went with his horses and chariots and stopped at the door of Elisha’s house. ¹⁰ Elisha sent a messenger to say to him, “Go, wash yourself seven times in the Jordan, and your flesh will be restored and you will be cleansed.” ¹¹ But Naaman went away angry and said, “I thought that he would surely come out to me and stand and call on the name of the Lord his God, wave his hand over the spot and cure me of my leprosy. ¹² Are not Abana and Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? Couldn’t I wash in them and be cleansed?” So he turned and went off in a rage. ¹³ Naaman’s servants went to him and said, “My father, if the prophet had told you to do some great thing, would you not have done it? How much more, then, when he tells you, ‘Wash and be cleansed’!”
- No matter what sickness or struggle we are encountering, God will help us overcome.
- Naaman followed his feeling and was outraged because Elisha did not do as he expected.
 - We must overcome these feelings.
 - We must not focus on our problems and how “impossible” they are because all things are possible with God.
- After Naaman overcame his feeling, he was able to receive not only healing but abundant life from God.
 - Naaman’s biggest blessing was that he was able to change his heart.
- (John 10:7) ⁷ Therefore Jesus said again, “Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. ⁸ All who have come before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them. ⁹ I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. ¹⁰ The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
- When Jesus comes, we will have life and have it to the full.
 - When we pray and ask God to heal us or solve our problems, we must overcome our own feelings.
 - These feelings might tell us that nothing is happening and that God is not healing us, however, we must pray and ask the Holy Spirit to help us overcome our feelings.
 - Satan uses these feelings to steal our healing and abundance from God.
- When we enter Jesus’ gate, we will be saved.
- The thief will always come first. If we are able to overcome, then we will receive God’s abundance.
- God has a designated place for us.
 - We must go to our designated church and worship and pray wholeheartedly.
- God does not only want to heal our bodies, but every aspect of our life.
- When we want to make any decisions, we must first pray and let Jesus help us.
 - We must understand that our feelings are not reliable and that we may fall into the trap of the thief’s stealing.
 - Jesus wants to help us enter the gate of abundance. When this door is opened by Jesus, nobody can shut it.
 - Therefore, we must allow Jesus to create in our lives.
- We must learn to pray until we walk out of ourselves and our feelings.
- When the light of God enters us our burdens and worries will leave us.
- When we pray in the name of Jesus, we overcome.

- When we overcome, Jesus will come and give us the message of life.
- We must ask for God's wisdom and insight when we have a problem.
 - We must not focus on the fact that we have a problem.

Romans 10:13-15 | Matthe 5:3 | Acts 2:1-11

- We must listen to the message until the word of God comes to us.
 - This was Paul's theology of victory and the key to his success.
- (Romans 10:13-15) ¹³ for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- ¹⁴ How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵ And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"
- Our decision making must rely on what God tells us.
- How do we hear the word of God?
 - We must diligently worship, praise, and listen to the message.
- We should not need to be reminded by others that we have to come to church.
 - We must have a heart that seeks and has a desire to hear the word from God.
- When the Holy Spirit comes upon us, the Holy Spirit will teach us all things.
- When our mind is empty, that is the time where the Holy Spirit can bring us instructions and direction.
- (Matthew 5:3) "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- We must come to church with a heart of reverence and worship.
 - Jesus wants to put the kingdom in our hearts, but we must first ready our hearts.
- (Matthew 16:19) I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."
- When we come to church with a heart that hungers and thirsts for the word, we will receive Jesus' blessing.
 - Church is not a regular place. It is where the Holy Spirit can enter your hearts and set you free.
- When we are able to overcome the thief, the word of Jesus will come to us.
- How do we overcome the thief?
 - We must pray until the Holy Spirit comes upon us.
- When we believe in God all things are possible.
 - We can't but God can do all things.
- What does it mean to be filled with the Holy Spirit?
 - Speaking in tongues and having the anointing and promise of God come upon us.
