Summary:

Judges 6:3-10 | Jeremiah 29:11 | Psalms 34:6 | Psalms 30:2 | John 7:38

- The Israelites lived in the land that the Lord gave them.
 - (Judges 6:10) I said to you, 'I am the Lord your God; do not worship the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you live.' But you have not listened to me."
 - We must be careful that we love nothing and no one more than we love God.
 - We must learn to love God more, and we will have the love of God in our life.
- If we ever find that things are not working out for us, we must carefully ponder if there is anything that we love more than God.
 - We must have the love of God in our daily lives, forgiving others and caring for others.
- When the Israelites disobeyed God and worshipped their idols, they were robbed, and their land was ruined.
 - We should not wait until we are suffering to call out to God.
- God is waiting for us to turn our eyes to Him and call out to Him and pray.
 - If we do not know how to pray, we can come to church to pray with others in groups.
 - We must pray until the Holy Spirit fills our heart, and we will have the strength to face our situation.
 - When we encounter troubles, we might be inclined to be discouraged and complain, but we must seek God and ask Him for help instead.

- In all that we do, whether things are going smoothly or we are encountering troubles, we must follow the way of God.
- It may not be easy, but we must call out to God and pray until we receive the direction that He has prepared for us.
 - In all we do, we must rejoice and praise the Lord, following His way.
- In our praise, we will see that our sorrows and troubles will be lifted.
 - (Psalms 34:6) This poor man called, and the Lord heard him; he saved him out of all his troubles.
 - We must learn to call out to God from the depths of our heart.
- The word of the Bible is the word of God.
 - If we keep this word in our heart, our faith will grow.
- When we continuously call out to the Lord with full faith, we will be healed, and our problems will be solved.
 - Even if the problem is caused by our own poor judgement, we can come before God to repent and return and call out to Him.
 - If we encounter troubles, we can call out to God and say, “Lord save me!”
 - (Matthew 14:30) But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, “Lord, save me!”
 - Our first course of action when we are in trouble is to turn to God.
 - We must not rely on our own feelings or the methods of the world.

Judges 6:11-16, 25-27 | Judges 7:1-7, 13-15, 21-22

- When the Israelites finally cried out to God for help, He appeared before Gideon and made him a judge to deliver the Israelites from their enemies.
 - If we want the Lord to appear to us, we must pray and praise daily and bring those around us to church.
- (Judges 6:11) The angel of the Lord came and sat down under the oak in Ophrah that belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, where his son Gideon was threshing wheat in a winepress to keep it from the Midianites.
 - In all that we do, we must prioritize taking care of God’s people and bringing more people to know Him.
- God examines our heart and knows all that we say and think.
 - When we align our heart to God and act in a way that pleases Him, we will receive great power and joy.
 - This joy is greater than any worldly method can buy.
- Gideon was a timid man, but God called him a mighty warrior.
 - We must believe that the man in Christ within us can bring about the courage that God has given us.
 - We must be willing to worship in full faith until we become a new creation in Christ.
- God looks at us with faith just like He looked at Gideon.
 - God will help us to believe in the strength that He has given us.
 - We must act upon the instruction that God gives us when He sends us.
- We must continue to come to church and call out to God.
 - When we draw closer to God, the more our spirit will grow.
 - As our spirit matures, we will find that the light of the Lord shines upon us, and we will exhibit the strength and courage that He has given us.
- When we have the Holy Spirit upon us, God will greatly use us.

- Before we can be used by God, we must rid ourselves of anything that we love more than God and make a sacrifice to Him.
- We must also call out to God cast out our doubt and fears in the name of Jesus.
- When we are obedient to God, He will help us to accomplish what He has planned for us.
- We must not allow ourselves to be discouraged or have doubt in our heart when we run into obstacles.
- (Judges 7:7) The Lord said to Gideon, “With the three hundred men that lapped I will save you and give the Midianites into your hands. Let all the others go home.”
 - When we follow the way that God has given us, we will find success regardless of how impossible it may seem.
- We must come to church to call out to God and pray until we no longer have the spirit of timidity.
 - (Judges 7:13-15) 13 Gideon arrived just as a man was telling a friend his dream. “I had a dream,” he was saying. “A round loaf of barley bread came tumbling into the Midianite camp. It struck the tent with such force that the tent overturned and collapsed.” 14 His friend responded, “This can be nothing other than the sword of Gideon son of Joash, the Israelite. God has given the Midianites and the whole camp into his hands.” 15 When Gideon heard the dream and its interpretation, he bowed down and worshiped. He returned to the camp of Israel and called out, “Get up! The Lord has given the Midianite camp into your hands.”
 - (Judges 7:21-22) 21 While each man held his position around the camp, all the Midianites ran, crying out as they fled. 22 When the three hundred trumpets sounded, the Lord caused the men throughout the camp to turn on each other with their swords. The army fled to Beth Shittah toward Zererah as far as the border of Abel Meholah near Tabbath.
 - The Lord will help us to rid ourselves of fear, timidity, and doubt.
 - When we have courage in our heart to do God’s work, we will find great success.
 - Our enemies will draw their swords on each other.
