Summary:

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 | John 14:21-24

- Deuteronomy 28 taught us the blessings for obedience and curses for disobedience.
 - Joseph’s life is a great example of blessings for obedience.
 - Throughout Joseph’s life, no matter what hardship he encountered, he always obeyed God.
 - Joseph was able to live such an obedient life because the Spirit of the Lord was in him.
- The key to our success is to listen to the word of God.
 - The words in the Bible.
 - The words God is giving us today.
- (John 14:21-24) 21 Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them.” 22 Then Judas (not Judas Iscariot) said, “But, Lord, why do you intend to show yourself to us and not to the world?” 23 Jesus replied, “Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. 24 Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me.
- John 14:21 tells us an important truth:
 - We must have God’s command and obeys them in everything that we do.
 - We must first have the command of God.
 - In all we do, we need God to command for us.

- In all we do, we must inquire of the Lord.
 - We must not walk in our own intelligence and feelings.
 - We must pray until God gives us the “yes or no”.
 - When we first receive God’s command before we act, we will be successful.
- When we obey God’s command, we are loving God.
- God called Jonah to Nineveh, however, he disobeyed and went to Tarshish.
 - Jonah’s disobedience caused his great suffering in the big fish.
- God commanded Noah to build an ark.
 - During the time of Noah, rain and floods had never happened before.
 - People mocked Noah, but he did not let it affect his obedience to God.
 - Because of this, Noah was able to save his entire family.
- Obedience is our key to success.
 - To attain great blessings, peace, and joy in our lives, we must obey the Lord.
 - When we obey, God will show Himself to us.
 - God will show Himself to us means He will guide us and lead us, bless us with His wisdom and knowledge.

John 1:1-5 | Psalms 103:18-19

- God loved Abraham so much because Abraham had both obedience, faith, and loved God with a sincere heart.
 - Abraham always walked in truth.
 - He never lied.
 - He always loved: He was generous to all and to the kingdom. He loved and took care of Lot.
 - He always forgave: He never held grudges against Lot.
 - When God called Abraham out of his land to a place he doesn’t know, he followed.
 - When God commanded Abraham to sacrifice his son, he did not complain or argue but was obedient.
 - God prepared a lamb for Abraham’s sacrifice.
- Abraham never took advantage of others.
 - He did not take from the King of Sodom.
 - He never gave anyone the chance to say that they had made Abraham rich.
 - Because Abraham truly knew that all his abundance was a blessing of God.
- Abraham put God as his highest priority.
 - When we put Jesus as our highest priority:
 - We will always trust in Jesus. Therefore, we will never lie.
 - We will always obey His command.
 - We will always love one another.
 - We will always forgive others.
 - How do we love Jesus?
 - We must love His word.
- (John 1:1-5) 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been

made. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

- Jesus is the word of God.
 - He is the word written in the Bible and the living word spoken to us today.
- Jesus is the creator of heaven and earth.
 - He created all of us and is still creating in us.
 - When we accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, we are a new creation in Christ.
 - When we come to church to worship and pray and let God create for us.
 - God will create for our business and heal us.
 - God is creating in all of us daily.
 - God wants us to become better and live better lives so that we may glorify the Lord.
- (Psalms 103:18-19) 18 with those who keep his covenant and remember to obey his precepts. 19 The Lord has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all.
 - Verse 18 tells us that we must first obey God's word.
 - When we walk with God and obey Him, He will create for us.
 - When we have the word of God, that is life and our commission.
 - When we obey and walk in His commission, the light of the Holy Spirit will come down.
 - The Holy Spirit will give us power, strength, and wisdom to carry out God's commission.
 - No matter what situation we are in, when the light of God is on us, we will be able to overcome.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 | 1 Samuel 15:22

- (2 Timothy 3:16-17) ¹⁶All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
 - The Bible is the word of God.
 - When we read the Bible, God will teach us.
 - God will teach us to walk in His righteousness.
 - God will rebuke and correct us and help us to walk in His way.
 - God will equip us to be His good servant and do every good work.
 - In the 66 books of the Bible, the laws and commands of God are clear.
 - The Holy Spirit will remind us when we go against God's command.
 - In our daily life, we must have the Bible as our guide and compass.
 - No matter what we are encountering, we must keep God's command.
 - If we obey God and serve Him wholeheartedly, God will bless us in every step of our lives.
 - Walk a life of obedience and obey God in even the smallest things. In all things, ask the Holy Spirit to teach us. We will see God's work in our lives in unimaginable ways
 - The Holy Spirit will guide us, lead us, and give us an opportunity to serve Him.
 - When we continuously read the bible and worship in the Spirit, the word of God will come to us.
 - Just like how Abraham had a sincere heart, we must also walk in truth.
 - Serving the Lord is one of the greatest blessings we can have.
 - We must have faith that when we follow God's command, God will prepare for us.

- When we obey God in small things, such as reading and Bible and pray and worship daily, God will continue to provide for us, bless us, and guide us in greater things.
- The greatest thing in life is accepting the Lord Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior.
 - Believe in the Lord your God and obey the Lord your God, you and your family will be saved.
- We must daily pray in the Spirit and worship until our worship touches God.
 - What does it mean to touch God?
 - The word in the Bible is logos.
 - The word of intuition, revelation, and prophecy that God spoken to us is rehema, the word God is giving us today.
 - We must touch God's heart, putting our all into God's work.
 - When we do this, God will speak to us and do great things for us.
 - Whatever our heart desires when we touch the heart of God, He will help us.
 - Hannah was barren, however, when her crying out to the Lord touched God's heart, she bore a son.
 - When Abraham was faithful in all he did, God told him in all things.
- When we receive the command from God, we must ask the Holy Spirit to help us obey.
 - Obedience is not easy.
 - Obedience cannot be accomplished by our own strength, but the Holy Spirit will help us overcome.
 - When we have God's command and obey them, we will see great miracles.
- Jesus will never give up on us and is patient with us.
 - Jesus is waiting to bless us.
 - The more we obey, the more we are blessed.
- (1 Samuel 15:22) But Samuel replied: "Does the LORD delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the LORD? To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams.
