Summary:

Acts 1:4-5 | John 1:1-4 | Matthew 14:28-29

- How do we let God perform miracles in our lives?
 - When we do according to God’s word, God will create for us.
 - We will discover that God is creating in our lives.
- We know that God is almighty. He is omnipresent and omniscient.
- (John 1:1-4) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. ⁴ In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.
- If we are able to keep God’s word and obey it, we will be a new creation in Christ.
 - We need God to create in every aspect of our lives.
- What is the Word?
 - The Word is Jesus.
 - Only through Jesus will we be able to have God’s creation power in us.
- (Matthew 14:28-29) “Lord, if it’s you,” Peter replied, “tell me to come to you on the water.” ²⁹ “Come,” he said.
- There are two kinds of faith.
 - The faith of man: faith in our selves.

- The faith from God: This faith comes from the word of God.
- Through Peter's faith from the word of God, he was able to walk on water.
- Our faith must grow in the word of God.
 - We must read the bible daily.
- We must ask God to help us and give thanks to Him.
- We must walk and pray daily.
 - The bible tells us that we must sweat from the brow.
- When we walk and pray, not only do we train our body, but we also train our spirit.
- When we take the step forward when Jesus says, "come," He will create for us.
- We must have the Holy Spirit move in our hearts daily.
 - When we pray, we must not be afraid.
 - We must sing, pray, and worship and allow the Holy Spirit to move and do wonderful things in our lives.
- God's word is the way.
 - It is the healing and creation.
- When we obey and act according to God's word, we will be made new.
 - There is nothing that God cannot create for us.
- We must proclaim daily and fight the battle with full faith.

John 3:3 | John 3:5 | Acts 1:4-5 | Acts 2:1-4

- If we want to see the kingdom of God, we must be born again.
- If we want to enter the kingdom of God, we must receive the baptism of water and the Holy Spirit.
- (John 3:3) ³ Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again."
- (John 3:5) Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit.
- (Acts 1:4-5) On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised which you have heard me speak about. 5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."
 - This was the command that God gave before He ascended to heaven.
- When we are filled with the Holy Spirit, we will be empowered.
- Through the blood of Jesus, our sins are forgiven, and we will have a new life.
- We must also be baptized with the Holy Spirit.
 - When the Holy Spirit comes upon us we will be able to speak in tongues.
- (Acts 2:1-4) When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. ² Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
 - The wind from heaven was moving amongst them.
 - Tongues of fire from the Holy Spirit came upon them, cleansing their tongues.
 - Then they were able to speak in tongues.

- (John 3:6-8) ⁶ Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. ⁷ You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' ⁸ The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."
 - When the wind blows, where it goes, we must go.
- If we are born of the Holy Spirit, we will know where it wants us to go not where we want to go.
 - This is a very important direction in our lives.
- The place that we are to be is determined not by ourselves but by God.
 - God knows what is best for us and our future.
- If we are wise, we will ask God to give us the direction through the Holy Spirit.

Genesis 12:1 | Genesis 12:4-8 | Hebrews 10:24-25 | Romans 10:14-15 | Hebrews 4:12

- Where we go is very important. We must go wherever God commands us.
 - Abraham followed and went to where God commanded him.
- (Genesis 12:1) The Lord had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.
- (Genesis 12:4-8) ⁴ So Abram went, as the Lord had told him; and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he set out from Harran. ⁵ He took his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot, all the possessions they had accumulated and the people they had acquired in Harran, and they set out for the land of Canaan, and they arrived there. ⁶ Abram traveled through the land as far as the site of the great tree of Moreh at Shechem. At that time the Canaanites were in the land. ⁷ The Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built an altar there to the Lord, who had appeared to him.
- When Abraham reached the place that God ap | pointed, he built an altar and God appeared to him.
 - Where God wants us to be, God will show Himself to us.
- If Abraham had not left where God had commanded him to be, what happened in Egypt would not have happened to him.
- When we leave where God tells us to be, we are finding trouble for ourselves.
- All of our blessings and the miracles that we receive all come from church.
 - We must not leave Jerusalem.
 - This means that we must not stop coming to church meetings.
 - When we give up meeting, we stop our blessings.
 - (Hebrews 10:24-25) ⁴ And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
- Reading the bible, praying, worshipping, and coming to meeting are very important.
 - (Romans 10:14-15) How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵ And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"
- We must first call on the Lord daily and believe that He will create for us.
- How do we believe in God?
 - We must call on the Lord until we hear from Him.

- Because of Jesus' salvation, we can live in the grace of God.
 - When Jesus tells us that we are healed we must not doubt.
 - We must give thanks to God and give Him all the glory.
- (Hebrews 4:12) For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
 - When the word of God enters us we will be healed.
 - God's word is better than anything a doctor can do.
- (Romans 10:17) Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ
 - We must listen to the message as often as we can.
