Summary:

Psalms 145:8-9 | Matthew 20:29-34

- (Psalms 145:8-9) The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. The Lord is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made.
- Compassion and mercy go hand in hand.
 - Jesus loves us tenderly and his compassion is for each and every one of us.
- All that we have and all of our blessings comes from the Lord.
 - Our salvation, our health, our business, and our success all come from God.
- Why does God continually protect us and provide for us?
 - God loves us and wants the best for us.
- As long as we come to church, worship, and learn God's word, we will hear from the Lord and encounter Him in our lives.
- Whenever we encounter troubles or hardships, we must call out.
 - When we kneel down, pray, and cry out, God will show compassion to us.
 - We must ask for the Holy Spirit and God's wisdom.
- When the Holy Spirit is in us we will receive guidance from the Holy Spirit.
- It is not by our own capacity or who we know that we have success, but because God has compassion on us and wants us to be blessed.

- Throughout the bible, we can see Jesus showing compassion for others and healing them.
 - When there is the compassion of the Lord, there will be miracles.
- God's love endures forever and His love will follow us wherever we go.
- (Matthew 20:29-34) 29 As Jesus and his disciples were leaving Jericho, a large crowd followed him. 30 Two blind men were sitting by the roadside, and when they heard that Jesus was going by, they shouted, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us!" 31 The crowd rebuked them and told them to be quiet, but they shouted all the louder, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us! 32 Jesus stopped and called them. "What do you want me to do for you?" he asked. 33 "Lord," they answered, "we want our sight." 34 Jesus had compassion on them and touched their eyes. Immediately they received their sight and followed him.
 - These men were blind and no doctor could heal them. No money could have ever fixed their eyesight.
 - They believed that Jesus was the Lord and called out earnestly and were healed.
- When we believe that Jesus is Lord, we will receive.
 - We must believe that all things are possible with God.
 - We must believe that Jesus will heal us and will show compassion to us.
- Even when the two blind men were being rebuked by the crowd, they continued to ask Jesus loudly.
 - We must not allow others to hinder us from coming to church. We must earnestly seek the Lord.

Psalms 34:4 | Psalms 34:17-20 | John 3:16

- When we encounter something that seems impossible and there is no way, we must trust in God and continue to call out to Him and seek His word and direction.
- (Psalms 34:4) I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears. 5 Those who look to him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame. 6 This poor man called, and the Lord heard him; he saved him out of all his troubles.
 - This was David's prayer when he needed help from the Lord.
- Whenever we face challenges, it is natural to fear and worry, however, we must seek God and ask for His anointing.
 - When we seek the Lord, He will shine his light on us and we will become radiant.
- (Psalms 34:17-20) The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles. 18 The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. 19 The righteous person may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers him from them all; 20 he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.
 - When we seek the Lord and call out to Him, He will deliver us not from only one or two problems but all of our difficulties.
 - Who are the righteous in this verse?
 - We are the righteous because we believe in God.
 - When we believe and ask God, He will answer our prayers.
- No matter what we did, as long as we receive Jesus as our Lord and savior, God will forgive us of all our sins and we will receive eternal life.
 - (John 3:16) For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Luke 7:11-15 | Matthew 5:7

- (Luke 11:7-15) 11 Soon afterward, Jesus went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a large crowd went along with him. 12 As he approached the town gate, a dead person was being carried out—the only son of his mother, and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the town was with her. 13 When the Lord saw her, his heart went out to her and he said, “Don’t cry.” 14 Then he went up and touched the bier they were carrying him on, and the bearers stood still. He said, “Young man, I say to you, get up!” 15 The dead man sat up and began to talk, and Jesus gave him back to his mother.
 - Jesus showed compassion to the widow and raised her son from the dead.
- God listens to all of our prayers and our crying out.
- When God shows compassion to us all things are possible.
 - God’s word has authority. When He commanded the boy to “get up” the dead man sat up and began to talk.
- Jesus blessed and healed people not to show His power and strength but to show compassion for us and to show His love to us.
- (Matthew 5:7) Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
 - When we receive compassion from the Lord, we must also show compassion to others.
- We must set time aside to spread the gospel and tell others about Jesus.
- No matter how different we are from other people, we must not push them away but bring them to church.
 - When must believe that when they receive the word of God, God will help them to change for the better.
- We must give thanks to God in all situations.
