- How can we overcome the world?
- (Philippians 4:12-13) 12 I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. 13 I can do all this through him who gives me strength.
- We need the word of God in our life, so we must spend at least 15 minutes a day to read the Bible.
- We must ask God for the strength to help others, not just monetarily but spiritually as well.
- No matter what people say or do, we must continue to have faith in God.
 - Jesus has already died on the cross for us, so we have already received healing for all of our sickness and help for all of our problems.
 - We can only receive the promises that God has made to us when we remove all doubt from our heart.
- We mustn't rely on worldly ways but only on God.
- God does not want His children to be in want.
 - Jesus is our living water, and when we drink of it, we will no longer thirst.
 - (John 4:13-14) Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

- We must earnestly seek the Holy Spirit, and when we receive the Spirit, we will also receive the promises of God.
- We must not allow ourselves to become sad or angry but be strong and courageous with the Spirit of God in our heart.
 - God will give us His authority; we just need to have faith in Him.
- We can give our sickness, burdens, and fears all to God, and we will receive healing and peace in return.
- Coming to church to worship and listen to the word of God is a joyful thing.
 - We can come to church to call out to God, and He will solve all of our problems and heal all of our sickness.
 - We are so blessed that we can come before God on the first day of the week to receive the promise of the Lord.
- When we leave church, we must not forget God and His promise to us.
 - We must not allow ourselves to criticize and judge others, complain, or become sad and angry.
- The first thing that we must overcome is the impossibilities of man.
 - We must change our thoughts to God's thoughts.
- Every word of God carries great authority.
 - We must call out to God and ask Him for His strength and authority in our everyday lives.
- We must don the garment of praise, covered in anointing and the glory of God.
 - We must praise and pray with joy and thanksgiving.
 - The more we pray and praise, the more power we will receive from God.
- We must pray, walk and sweat, and praise daily with joy and thanksgiving and we will have a healthy body and successful endeavors.
- We must be like Paul who has a heart seeking the Lord.
- God, through our prayers, will give keep us in His peace beyond understanding.
- Whenever we encounter troubles, we must not panic or worry but lift our hands and call out to God.
- It is not by our own authority or ability that we can do things but by the authority and power of God.
 - (Psalms 103:19) The Lord has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all.

Joshua 5:13-15 | Matthew 7:7-8 | Matthew 5:3-12 | Joshua 6, 7 | John 18:6

- Joshua knew that the first thing he should do in the morning is to call out to God and worship.
 - First thing in the morning, we must call out to God and ask us to give us our daily manna.
 - (Matthew 7:7-8) 7 "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.
- Jesus gave the Beatitudes to the disciples as they were walking, so we must walk and pray daily.
- (Joshua 5:13-15) 13 Now when Joshua was near Jericho, he looked up and saw a man standing in front of him with a drawn sword in his hand. Joshua went up to him and asked, "Are you for us or for our enemies?" 14 "Neither," he replied, "but as commander of the army of the Lord I have now come." Then Joshua fell facedown to the ground in reverence, and asked him, "What message does my Lord have for his servant?" 15 The commander of the Lord's army replied, "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy." And Joshua did so.

- Jesus comes to give us our way and to be the commander of our life.
- God wants to help us, no one can be against us, but we cannot follow our own thoughts and feelings or the ways of the world.
- We must have our direction from God and follow it.
 - (Joshua 6:1-4) 1 Now the gates of Jericho were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in. 2 Then the Lord said to Joshua, "See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men. 3 March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days. 4 Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets.
 - When Joshua received and followed his direction and method from God to take down Jericho, the Israelites were successful.
 - However, the Israelites failed to take the small city of Ai, they followed their own feelings, and they went against God, keeping the devoted things from Jericho
- We must fall before God, letting go of our self and receiving the word of God.
 - Our church is the place where we can come to receive anointing and blessings.
 - (John 18:6) When Jesus said, "I am he," they drew back and fell to the ground.
 - God is omniscient and omnipotent, so if we have any problems, we can call out to God for help.
