Summary:

Luke 17:11-19 | Psalms 119:89, 93

- The ten men with leprosy heard that Jesus healed many people, including those with leprosy.
 - At the time, there was no cure for leprosy, and those with leprosy were to be separated from society.
 - When they heard that Jesus was a method to cure their sickness, they went out to meet Jesus.
- Why do we come to church?
 - We come to pray and praise so that we can see God.
- When we cry out to Jesus, we need to do it right.
 - Our God is a God of great mercy, sending Jesus to free us from our sins and sickness.
- Once Jesus saw the ten lepers, He told them to be checked by the priests.
 - On their way, they were healed.
- We need to have faith that God can heal us.
- (Psalms 119:89) Your word, Lord, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens.
 - The word of God has authority, and it can change our entire life.
- If we ever encounter troubles in our life, we have the blessing of being able to come to morning prayer meetings every day other than Monday.
 - If we come to church daily, our hearts will be set free.
 - When we put our problems before the Lord, He sees.
 - We must, 7 times a day, come before God to call out to Him for help.

- When our minds are full of thoughts not from the Lord, we can keep the word of God in our heart.
 - (Psalms 119:93) I will never forget your precepts, for by them you have preserved my life.
 - This word of God in our heart can save our life.
 - This is how we can have living water pour out from within us.
- Only by the blameless blood of Jesus can cleanse all of mankind.
 - When Mary heard that she would be the one to give birth to Jesus, she was concerned.
 - However, the angel told her that every word of God carries authority.
 - The word of God is beyond even our imagination, so when we receive it, we must do accordingly.
- We must not rely on our own ability or the recommendations of professionals but only on God.
 - Peter fished for an entire night, catching nothing, but when he obeyed Jesus' command after listening to His message, he caught so many fish that his boat and the boat that came to help almost sank.
 - The blessing of the Lord is overflowing.
 - To those that serve the Lord, His blessings are without worries and troubles.

Micah 4:2 | Luke 17:15-19, 20-21 | Matthew 5:1-11 | 1 Samuel 24

- (Micah 4:2) Many nations will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the temple of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths." The law will go out from Zion,
 - We must make sure that we continue to come to church to pray and call out to God.
 - God will protect us, our family, our business, our coming and going, and every other aspect of our life.
 - In the end times, all will come to the mountain of the Lord.
- There are three Jerusalem:
 - The Jerusalem that is in heaven.
 - The physical Jerusalem in Israel.
 - The Jerusalem that is our church, where we come to receive healing, blessings, and our direction and method.
- (Luke 17:15-19) 15 One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. 16 He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan. 17 Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? 18 Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" 19 Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."
 - Jesus was overjoyed that the Samaritan:
 - returned and praised God in a loud voice giving thanks and glory to the Lord.
 - fell facedown before the Lord to give thanks.
- The thanksgiving faith of the Samaritan that returned to give thanks to the Lord completely separates him from the rest that did not return.
 - This is what allowed him to receive full healing.
 - He was the only one to receive Jesus tell him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."
 - He was healed completely, received God's blessing, and those around him were blessed as well.
- The kingdom of God is in our heart.
 - (Luke 17:20-21) 20 Once, on being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, Jesus replied, "The coming of the kingdom of God is not something that can be observed, 21 nor will people say, 'Here it is,' or 'There it is,' because the kingdom of God is in your midst."

- When the kingdom of God is in our heart, we will have renewed faith and the peace that God gives us.
- When we truly seek God and build our relationship with him, we will receive the Holy Spirit.
 - We must learn to become poor in spirit so that we can have the word of God and the Holy Spirit in our heart.
- (Matthew 5:3) “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.”
 - The only other that receives this same blessing of the kingdom of heaven are those who are persecuted for righteousness.
- (Matthew 5:10) Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
 - This persecution is something that we cannot avoid, but rather, we should rejoice when we are persecuted because God will protect us and bless us.
- When David experienced persecution from Saul, he did not attempt to harm him in any way even when he had a open opportunity.
 - David knew full well that Saul was the Lord’s anointed, and he should not lay a hand on him.
- The whole Bible is full of God’s love and warnings to us so that we can continue to find favor in Him.
 - Therefore, we must keep the word of God in our heart and act upon it daily.
