Summary:

John 1:29 | Matthew 24:3-5 | Matthew 27:45-46 | Isaiah 53:4-6

- Church is the house of God, gate of heaven, and we must come to praise the Lord.
- There are many distractions in the world, especially now during the end-times.
 - We must be careful and prepare ourselves, being filled with the Holy Spirit and receiving our direction from God.
- We need only the truth, the word of God, in our life.
- The cross is a severe and harsh punishment for criminals, crucifying them.
 - Because of the jealousy of the Pharisees and Sadducees of the time, they captured Jesus and subject Him to this harsh punishment.
- Jesus' goal in coming to Earth was to save many, and He was willing to sacrifice Himself so that we may receive salvation.
 - Jesus was willing to deny Himself and be set lower than God, taking on the bondage of sin and dying for us.
- (Isaiah 53:4-6) 4 Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the

punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. 6 We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

- Though blameless and pure, Jesus bore the punishment of all of our sin on the cross.

- We must not allow ourselves to be enslaved by the things of the world.
 - (Romans 6:6-7) 6 For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin— 7 because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.
 - (Romans 6:16) Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey—whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?
- (1 Corinthians 6:19-20) Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.
 - The Holy Spirit wants to dwell in us to give us the strength of God, but we must take care of our body.
 - Only by the anointing of the Holy Spirit will we be able to be set free from.
- (Romans 7:21-25) 21 So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me. 22 For in my inner being I delight in God's law; 23 but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me. 24 What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? 25 Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!
 - We must be willing to seek Jesus daily so that we do not trap ourselves in a cycle of sin and regret.
- (Hebrews 9:13-14) 13 The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that they are outwardly clean. 14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!
 - (John 1:29) The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!
 - Only by Jesus' blood are we cleansed of our sins.
- Jesus is our one and only salvation.
 - Jesus took our sins upon Himself and allowed them to die with Him on the cross.
- The Holy Spirit wants to dwell in us, and when we allow Him to fill us, we will become a new creation in Christ.
 - (2 Corinthians 5:17) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!
- There is nothing that we need to do in order to receive the wondrous salvation of Jesus.
 - All we need to do is proclaim with our mouth that Jesus is our Lord.
 - We must have full faith that our God is the God of resurrection and that His resurrection power can create in our lives.

- (John 14:6) Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.
 - We must learn to follow Jesus’ direction for us.
 - By God’s authority, all things are possible for us.
- (Psalms 103:19) The Lord has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all.
 - God knows all and rules over all, so we do not need to worry about our problems or sickness because He will help us and heal us.
 - We need only come to church and humble ourselves before Him and call out to Him.
